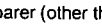

Gleaner Fraternal Scholarship Benefit

Gleaner scholarship opportunities are a fraternal benefit for Gleaner family members pursuing post secondary education. They are provided by the Gleaner Life Insurance Society Scholarship Foundation.

Gleaner scholarships are limited to one per student. Applicants *who do not* receive a scholarship may reapply the following year as long as they continue to meet the eligibility requirements. Awards are not limited to one per household.

Eligibility Requirements

To apply for a Gleaner scholarship, students must:

1. Be a Gleaner member or a member of a Gleaner family; (ie, parent, child, grandchild, sibling)
2. Be a high school senior or high school graduate,
3. Plan to or currently attend an accredited vocational/technical school, college, university or graduate school within the United States, and
4. Enroll as a full-time student taking 10 or more semester credit hours.

There are no age restrictions; non-traditional students are encouraged to apply.

Students who have experienced difficulty in attaining academic success earlier in life but who have demonstrated definite improvement are equally eligible.

A minimum grade point average is not required for application.

Judgement Criteria

Applicants are judged by an independent panel of judges. Judges are appointed by the Scholarship Foundation's board of directors with the sole responsibility of determining scholarship recipients. Applicants are scored individually on six basic items: 1) Completion of the application, 2) Leadership, 3) Quality of extracurricular activities and community involvement, 4) Letters of recommendation, 5) Applicant's personal statement, and 6) Overall quality of the application. Applicants must complete all questions and include all required documents.

Composition and completion of the application is critical. Decisions by the selection committee are based upon written material submitted to the Gleaner Life Insurance Society Scholarship Foundation. Application materials are accepted starting December 1 and must be received by the Scholarship Foundation no later than March 1.

Awards

The number of scholarship awards vary from year to year depending upon funds available. Awards are expected to be used for educational expenses governed by the school.

The minimum amount of each scholarship is \$1,000.

Book assistance awards of various amounts may also be available. The proceeds are to be applied toward the purchase of textbooks and supplies.
