The chairperson of the Board of Directors or committee shall, if appropriate, appoint a disinterested person or committee (including outside advisors) to investigate alternatives to the proposed transaction or arrangement, and to advise whether the proposed transaction or arrangement is in Taxpayers's best interest.
- 4. The Board of Directors or committee shall exercise due diligence to determine whether Taxpayer can, with reasonable efforts, obtain a more advantageous transaction or arrangement that would not give rise to a conflict of interest.
- 5. If a more advantageous transaction or arrangement is not reasonably attainable under circumstances that would not give rise to a conflict of interest, the Board of Directors or committee shall determine by a majority vote of the disinterested directors and members whether the proposed transaction or arrangement is in Taxpayers's best interest and for its own benefit and whether the transaction is fair and reasonable to Taxpayer, and shall make its decision as to whether to enter into

- 6. The minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors and all Spectrum Health committees shall set forth:
- a) The names of the persons who disclosed a financial interest in a proposed transaction or arrangement involving Spectrum Health or any of its subsidiaries and the nature of the financial interest; and b) The names of the persons who were present for discussions and votes relating to such transaction or arrangement, including any discussion of alternatives to the proposed transaction or arrangement, and a record of any votes taken in connection with that matter. The votes of individual members need not be recorded unless otherwise directed by the Board of Directors or committee

### MANAGEMENT

- 1.Each member of the management team shall complete a Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form upon acceptance of an employment offer and at any point thereafter if a new potential conflict of interest has arisen. The conflict of interest disclosure form should be fully completed and signed. If the staff member discloses any potential conflict of interest, the form shall be submitted immediately to the System's Organizational Integrity Department. A copy of the completed form should be maintained in the staff member's personnel file.
- 2. Each member of the management team shall complete an electronic Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form on an annual basis. The conflict of interest

disclosure form should be completed and electronically signed within the given timeframe. The System's Organizational Integrity Department will manage the annual process and will maintain electronic copies of the completed forms.

- 3. The System's Organizational Integrity Department shall review each form that is submitted. Additional information will be gathered as needed. Whether any items disclosed may be perceived as an actual or potential conflict of interest will be reviewed. In addition, steps that can be taken to reduce the risk of a conflict of interest will be identified.
- 4.If the System's Organizational Integrity Department believes that a disclosure has been made that comprises an actual or perceived conflict of interest, the System Conflict of Interest Committee or members thereof will be consulted as needed. The staff member's Supervisor and/or Human Resources Generalist may be consulted as well. Reasonable steps should be taken as needed to minimize the risk of a conflict of interest. A written memo summarizing these steps should be sent to the staff member's Supervisor and be maintained in the staff member's file.
