WPR's mission is to serve the entire state by producing, acquiring and delivering high quality audio programming that serves the public's need to discuss ideas and opinions, and that provides cultural enrichment, intellectual stimulation, and intelligent, enlightening entertainment through the Wisconsin Public Radio Network. WPR's most recent annual report indicates nearly 444,000 public radio listeners per week. During the 2010 fiscal year, there were 36,000 public radio contributors. Wisconsin Public Radio broadcasts from thirty-one radio stations throughout the state and streams live on the internet providing programs from three networks: the Ideas Network, The NPR News & Classical Music Network and the 24-hour HD2 Classical Music Network.

This includes educational program development and delivery of Instructional Television, Online and Multimedia Resources to students and teachers in Wisconsin. These resources are developed by WPT's parner, the Wisconsin Educational Communications Board. The ECB also develops educational resources such as interactive Web sites, datacasting, computer software, DVD's and CD-ROMs. ECB broadcasts over 429 hours of educational content statewide during the school year via WPT. WPT's most recent annual report indicates nearly 494,000 Wisconsin households view WPT each week, and during the 2010 fiscal year there were 29,169 public television contributors.
