	workforce development services, and catalyze the integration of workforce and economic development. The Initiative ran from 2007 through June 30, 2010 in the seven county region of Southeastern Wisconsin, which includes Waukesha, Washington, Ozaukee, Milwaukee, Kenosha, Racine, and Walworth counties. Waukesha-Ozaukee-Washington Workforce Development Inc. served as the fiscal and administrative agent for this initiative, which involved partnership with many organizations and individuals representing education, economic, workforce and community development. WOW WDI had one staff person dedicated to monitoring subcontracts that were issued through the Initiative By and throughout 2009, investments were made in a litany of projects to change workforce development in Southeastern Wisconsin. By the start of 2009, thirty-four investments had been made through the first and second rounds of the Innovation Fund and a number of transformation investments were also underway. By the end of the Initiative, the Southeastern Wisconsin WIRED innovation Fund made awards to forty-six (46) diverse and varied projects in three tiers from April of 2008 through August 2009. Thirteen (13) WIRED investments also supported transformation and priority projects including (1) Research-Related Priorities, (2) Data System-Related Priorities, and (3) Talent Development Priorities for Driver Industries WIRED invested in seeds of transformation in a number of areas. For example, some WIRED projects created career pathways and bridges to career pathways, like the Milwaukee SOLAR program, Industrial Machine Repair Bootcamp, Pre-College Capacity Building Project, and Articulation Agreement Taskforce. Other WIRED projects promoted education innovation such as Science Technology Engineering Art & Math (STEAM), BizLearn, Opening Doors, and On Ramp. Many also provided Southeastern Wisconsin workers and youth with opportunities to build skills and improve their employability through innovative training like THINK Insurance and Running Rebels Project-B
