DURING THESE DELIBERATIONS, THE COMMITTEE ALSO CONSIDERS INPUT OBTAINED FROM OTHER BOARD MEMBERS, STAFF, PROFESSIONAL ADVISORS, GRANT RECIPIENTS, AND OTHER INFORMED COMMUNITY LEADERS. THE DATE OF DELIBERATIONS AND SUBSEQUENT MEETING WITH PRESIDENT/CEO ARE DOCUMENTED IN THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD MEETING AND THE OUTCOME MAINTAINED IN THE CONFIDENTIAL PERSONNEL FILES OF THE ORGANIZATION.
