SIGNATURE PROGRAMS:

THE SUNSET PARK ALLIANCE IS AN INNOVATIVE NEIGHBORHOOD-BASED STRATEGIC COLLABORATIVE EFFORT TO SERVE ALL OUT OF SCHOOL YOUNG ADULTS IN THIS BROOKLYN COMMUNITY. BY ASSEMBLING A MULTIPLE AGENCY CONTINUUM OF SERVICES THE RATIONALE WAS THAT IF EVERY YOUNG PERSON RECEIVED THE RIGHT SERVICES AT THE RIGHT TIME OUTCOMES WOULD IMPROVE SIGNIFICANTLY. THE STRATEGY INCLUDES CENTRALIZED INTAKE AND CASE MANAGEMENT AND MORE PROVIDER SPECIALIZATION. THIS IS THE FIRST MULTI-PARTNER COMMUNITY-BASED COLLABORATIVE OF ITS KIND IN NYC, WHICH FOCUSES ON BOTH A HOLISTIC APPROACH TO SERVICE TO YOUNG PEOPLE BASED ON THEIR CURRENT NEEDS, AND A STRATEGIC APPROACH TO LOCAL AREA EMPLOYERS THAT ARE COMMITTED TO ULTIMATELY HIRING YOUNG PEOPLE PREPARED THROUGH THE PROGRAM. THIS PROJECT IS BEGINNING ITS SECOND YEAR OF SERVICES; HENCE OUTCOMES FOR THE PROJECT ARE STILL IN DEVELOPMENT AND ARE CURRENTLY BEING ARTICULATED.

THE BRONX OPPORTUNITY NETWORK'S COLLEGE ACCESS AND ENRICHMENT PROGRAM ADDRESSES A CRITICAL PROBLEM FACING NYC; NAMELY, HOW TO PREPARE A HIGHER PERCENTAGE OF YOUNG ADULTS LIVING IN LOW-INCOME NEIGHBORHOODS TO GRADUATE FROM CUNY'S COMMUNITY COLLEGES WITH THE SKILLS AND CREDENTIALS TO FULLY PARTICIPATE IN THE CITY'S COMPETITIVE LABOR MARKET. RECOGNIZING THAT A MAJOR REASON FOR THE HIGH FAILURE RATE IS THAT THE MAJORITY OF PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS LACK SUFFICIENT PREPARATION FOR COLLEGE-LEVEL WORK, THIS PROGRAM COMBINES INTENSIVE ACADEMIC REMEDIATION WITH CASE MANAGEMENT AND CAREER DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT TO ENSURE THAT PARTICIPANTS HAVE ALL THE TOOLS NEEDED TO SUCCEED. A KEY FOCUS FOR THIS PROJECT IS BOTH PREPARING YOUNG PEOPLE WITH SUFFICIENT ACADEMIC RIGOR PRIOR TO THEIR TAKING THE COLLEGE PLACEMENT EXAMS (AS TO AVOID REMEDIAL CLASSES), AND TO ASSIST YOUNG PEOPLE TO NAVIGATE THE COLLEGE SETTING, INCLUDING DEVELOPING SOUND STUDY HABITS, CRITICAL THINKING, AND SELF-ADVOCACY SKILLS. A MAJOR GOAL FOR THIS PROJECT IS TO ENSURE THAT ALL THE PARTICIPANTS COMPLETE A FORMAL VOCATIONAL ASSESSMENT/PLAN SO THAT THEIR DEGREE PROGRAM OF CHOICE CAN BE ALIGNED WITH ACTUAL JOB OPPORTUNITIES IN THE LOCAL AND REGIONAL ECONOMY.

THE LOWER EAST SIDE EMPLOYMENT NETWORK COORDINATES A RANGE OF PREPARATORY SERVICES TO PREPARE YOUNG ADULTS FOR NEW ENTRY LEVEL JOB OPPORTUNITIES CREATED BY THE OPENING OF HOTELS AND RETAIL STORES ON THE LOWER EAST SIDE. THE LOWER EAST SIDE, DESPITE THE ECONOMY, HAS EXPERIENCED A BOON IN BOTH THE RETAIL AND HOSPITALITY SECTORS COINCIDING WITH A DRAMATIC GENTRIFICATION OF THIS COMMUNITY IN THE PAST FIVE YEARS. SEVERAL SMALLER, NON-UNION HOTELS ARE IN DEVELOPMENT OR HAVE BEEN RECENTLY OPENED. AS PART OF THIS INITIATIVE, THREE PROMINENT YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS SERVING YOUNG PEOPLE FROM THIS NEIGHBORHOOD; CHINESE AMERICAN PLANNING COUNCIL,

THE DOOR, AND HENRY STREET SETTLEMENT - ALONG WITH OTHER PARTNERS - HAVE CONVENED TO WORK COLLABORATIVELY IN ORDER TO CREATE A TALENT PIPELINE FOR THESE EMERGING EMPLOYERS WITHIN TARGETED GROWTH INDUSTRIES. IN THE COMING YEAR, THIS PROGRAM SEEKS TO RAISE THE COLLECTIVE RESOURCES TO HIRE A BROKER/EMPLOYER LIAISON THAT WILL WORK AS A CONDUIT AMONG THE EMPLOYER COMMUNITY IN THE AREA AND THE COLLABORATIVE DIRECT SERVICE WORKFORCE PARTNERS OF THE INITIATIVE.

THE WEST HARLEM PROJECT WILL DEVELOP A PLACE-BASED STRATEGY IN AN AREA WITH HIGH NEED AND MUCH LESS CURRENT SERVICE CAPACITY THAN OTHER AREAS WHERE JOBSFIRST NYC HAS WORKED WITH THE OTHER COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS. UNLIKE JOBSFIRST NYC'S EARLIER PROJECTS, THIS PROJECT FOCUSES ON BRINGING IN NEW RESOURCES TO AN AREA WHERE NONE EXIST FOR DISCONNECTED YOUTH, RATHER THAN CONVENING AND FOSTERING COLLABORATION AMONG EXISTING RESOURCES. DESPITE BOTH GENTRIFICATION AND THE DRAMATIC GROWTH OF COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY IN RECENT YEARS, THE AREA OF WEST HARLEM IS COMPLETELY WITHOUT FORMAL SERVICES FOR DISCONNECTED YOUNG ADULTS. JOBSFIRST NYC HAS FORMED A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY, THE LOCAL COMMUNITY BOARD # 9, AND OTHER KEY STAKEHOLDERS TO PROVIDE A SERVICE PIPELINE AND OUTREACH EFFORT TO DISCONNECTED YOUNG ADULTS RESIDING IN THIS AREA. THIS PROJECT IS IN THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT STAGES.
