The Boss Foundation is a private foundation which distributes the income from its investments each fiscal year. The grants are distributed to qualified 501(c)(3) organizations furthering or engaged in the performing and fine arts. The fiscal year of the foundation ends on June 30.

Proposals may be submitted at any time; however, the Board of Directors customarily meets in the fall to decide on distributions of the year. Proposals received by June 1 will receive priority consideration. Proposals must be in the form set forth below.

PHYSICAL COMPOSITION OF PROPOSAL:

The proposal shall consist of five pages.

- Page 1: A one-page letter addressed to the President from your President or other person authorized by your organization to solicit contributions. In this letter, state:
