**Black Hawk-Grundy Mental Health Center** 0733463 42 Part III, 4a: Mental Health Services Program Black Hawk-Grundy Mental Health Center, Inc. (the Center)'s mental health services program's objective is to provide a variety of mental health services to people in Black Hawk and Grundy Counties at no or low cost based upon a sliding fee scale. During FY10, the Center's outpatient services provided 2,552 psychiatric evaluations, 24,074 individual therapy and medication management sessions and 1,278 group therapy sessions to over 4,500 individuals. The Center provided assistance to homeless individuals in the form of evaluations, outreach services, assistance in accessing benefits and other provider services, funding for bus tickets and assistance in locating housing. In FY10, assistance was provided to 293 homeless individuals. The Center provided services to inmates with a co-occurring disorder at the Waterloo Department of Correctional Services Residental Facility. These services included evaluations, medication management and group therapy. Services were provided to approximately 90 individuals during FY10. The Center provided school based mental health services to youth in the public schools. In FY10, 210 youth and family were seen for direct clinical care and group sessions on anger management, social skills and coping with depression were provided. The Center provided outreach services to individuals with a serious and persistent mental illness in an effort to prevent or reduce hospitalizations and institutional placements while promoting independence in the community. In FY10, the Center provided 6,765 outreach visits to approximately 400 individuals in their homes or in the community. The Center provided home-based mental health services to individuals over the age of 60 who are at risk of placement in a more restrictive environment due to untreated mental and medical problems. During FY10, the Center provided services to 70 individuals over the age of sixty in their homes. The Center provided peer support services through a Mental Health Recovery Center located in downtown Waterloo. The services were provided by consumers who have been trained to provide peer support with clincial oversight by a Licensed Social Worker. During FY10, six trained consumers provided peer support services to approximately 22 individuals per month. Approximately 125-150 other consumers visited the Recovery Center during each month for information, referral, educational resources and support groups. The Center provided nursing services to clients who needed medications. They provided telephone triage, pharmacy calls for new or renewal medications, access to pharmaceutical patient assistance programs, education and injections. During a typical week the nursing staff had direct contact with over 500 individuals. Currently over 1,300 clients receive free medication through these programs. During FY10 the Center's nursing staff placed patient assistance medication orders each month for free medication with an annual value of over \$3 millon. Through a grant from the 1st Judicial Department the Center implemented the second Mental Health Court project in the State of Iowa in collaboration with the Black Hawk County Attorney and the State Public Defenders Office in July 2009. In the first year 113 were screened, 25 accepted into the program with only two who did not complete the program and were sent to prison. The Center also provided consultation and education services. In FY10, formal presentations were made to over 1,500 individuals in the community. Informal consulatations and educational activities occurred daily.
