Part I, Line 7g Towner County Medical Center operates two clinics and one emergency room in their service area The cost of the operations of the clinics was \$1,286,408

Part I, Line 7f For the purpose of calculating the percentage on Part I, line 7f, \$256,834 of bad debt expense was backed out of total operating expenses

Part I, Line 7 The Organization used Worksheet 2 to determine the cost of charity care Part I, Line 7B. The Medicaid cost report was used to calculate the amount of unreimbursed Medicaid Part I, Line 7E. This amount includes health fair actual expenses for supplies and salaried employee time. In addition, the amount includes the cost of Wellness Screenings. There were 522 screenings completed at an estimated cost of \$45 per screening Part I, Line 7F. This amount was calculated by taking the total salary and benefits of the pharmacy intern and the medical student that served in the facility during the year and multiplying that amount by 15%, which is the percentage of time TCMC considered as an education cost.

Part III, Line 4 Bad debt expense was converted to cost using the ratio of patient care cost to charges calculated using Worksheet 2 The methodology for determining the amount of the organization's bad debt expense attributable to patients that would be eligible under the organization's charity care policy was calculated by taking the total cost of charity care in relation to total revenue from the hospital, physicians and clinic and then applied this ratio against bad debt expense Subsequent to year end, Towner County Medical Center adopted a policy to track how many charity care applications are requested Financial Statement Footnote for Bad Debt Expense The carrying amount of patient and resident receivables is reduced by a valuation allowance that reflects management's best estimate of amounts that will not be collected from patients, residents, and third-party payors. Management reviews patient and resident receivables by payor class and applies percentages to determine estimated amounts that will not be collected from third parties under contractual agreements and amounts that will not be collected from patients and residents due to bad debts. Management considers historical write off and recovery information in determining the estimated bad debt provision.

Part III, Line 9b After a patient receives two statements without making a payment, TCMC will call the patient to discuss their past due account. After the third statement is sent out the patient also receives a written notice saying they are being sent to collections and this notice also provides a number for them to contact TCMC about their past due account. If the patient does get in contact with TCMC they will offer the patient Charity Care at that time and the patient will need to complete the steps to see if they qualify for charity care.

The median household income is \$45,500 and the average household size is 2 31 12 1% of the patients who received services in 2010 were uninsured or Medicaid recipients. There are two hospitals within 40-55 miles of Towner County Medical Center. One is in Rolla, which is within 10 miles from the Turtle Mountain Indian Reservation. The other is in Devils Lake which is within 10 miles from the Spirit Lake Indian Reservation.

Recent additional services added have been sleep studies, E-Emergency, Telepharmacy TCMC provides specialty cardiac rehab, cancer outpatient services, and operates emergency room regardless of ability to pay TCMC is the sole community provider of healthcare services in this community III Community outreach with public entitiesTowner County was the last county in the state of North Dakota to not have a county public health office In conjunction with the county, Towner County Medical Center took on the responsibility of starting up the public health office. The program, which is funded by Towner County and through grants provides many services, such as immunizations, baby checks, car seats and other services, to those in need. It is through cooperation, such as this, that Towner County Medical Center is able to reach out and provide services to those most in need, who may not otherwise be able to receive these types of preventative services IV. Community outreach for the broader communityTowner County Medical Center offers a number of services to individuals in the region aimed at providing preventative services, educational services and chronic care management services Foot care - Towner County Medical Center routinely provides foot care clinics for the elderly, both here in Cando and in the outlying areas upon request Senior meals/senior center - Towner County Medical Center provides senior meals. Seniors either come to the medical center to eat their lunches or they are taken out to them through the use of volunteers In addition to the meals, Towner County Medical Center also offers its conference room as a gathering place for the seniors in the community and area to come socialize, play cards or to have other events. The use of the space is weekly and there is no cost to the seniors for the use of this space Medical education - Towner County Medical Center serves as an active participant in the University of North Dakota Medical School training program. Serving as a site for various medical students, we also serve as a clinical site for nurses in training, certified nursing assistant in training, and for other fields in which we have appropriately trained staff and facilities to assist in the training process Other - we encourage physicians and other staff to be active participants in the community. We have staff actively involved in economic development, in youth sports, in the fine arts, and in community leadership positions. It is through this active partnership that Towner County Medical Center is able to contribute to the community to make it a better place to live and an area that people desire to move
