The quantitative source was an analytical analysis of the amount of charity care given by Community Hospital compared to the local demographics for poverty based on US Census data. One of the assumptions made was that most individuals that would have qualified for charity care but would not apply ended up as bad debt write-offs of the Hospital This analysis showed that approximately 5% of the bad debt expense was likely to have come from individuals that would have qualified for charity care had they applied. The qualitative source we employed was to ask our staff that routinely handle charity care applications and bad debt determinations, what percentage, in their professional opinion, of bad debt was from individuals that would have likely qualified for the charity care program had the patient applied for assistance.
