Community Mental Health Services (CMHS) funds are available for residents of Harvey, McPherson and Marion counties in Kansas who qualify based on family income and the number of family members Qualification for these funds will be determined upon admission based upon the approved schedules and policies In order to qualify for financial assistance, the patient is expected to provide all personal and family financial information requested by the financial counselor in addition to all insurance information. No resident of the three counties noted above will be denied CMHC medically necessary and appropriate services because of their inability or refusal to pay

Part VI, Line 4 Prairie View provides mental and behavioral healthcare services to anyone in need, without discrimination or regard to race, religion, creed or gender. When Prairie View was established in 1954, its founders envisioned a psychiatric health facility that would offer humane, quality care Prairie View began with a commitment to do things better and a desire to provide the kind of mental health care individuals would want for themselves and for their loved ones. Over half a century later, their mission remains focused and impassioned. "to foster healing and growth in individuals and communities by providing mental and behavioral healthcare services with competence, compassion, and stewardship in the spirit of Christ "Prairie View serves individuals throughout the state of Kansas from its headquarters in Newton, regional outpatient locations in Hutchinson, McPherson, Hillsboro and Wichita, and satellite outpatient services for children and the elderly in surrounding counties In addition to the psychiatric hospital housed in Newton, a residential program is available for children 12 to 17 years of age Children younger than 12 receive mental health screening and evaluation, psychiatric supportive treatment, individual and group treatment, wrap-around services and home-based family therapy. Each year more than 12,500 individuals receive services through Prairie View Prairie View offers in-patient services to transition individuals from acute hospital care to community-based support. A Special Purpose School located in Newton serves children identified as Emotionally Disturbed (ED) or with Pervasive Developmental Delays (PDD)-studentw with behavioral issues which cannot be managed in a traditional academic setting Prairie View offers a full range of alcohol and substance abuse services and pro-active community outreach that includes case management, residential and vocational services, and educational programs to inform the general public about various mental health issues as well as to encourage empathy and understanding Ultimately, the goal is to be there for the most vulnerable in the community
