Part VI, Line 2 The Medical Center was a funding sponsor of the 2009-2010 Health Risk Behaviors-Reno County survey in collaboration with the Kansas Health Foundation, Hutchinson Community Foundation, and the Reno County Health Department and Home Health Agency The survey measures and sets target goals for seven leading health indicators for the county the Medical Center serves. A member of the Medical Center's Executive Team serves on the Advisory Board of the Reno County Health Department. This board is currently forming sub-committees and an action plan for response to the survey and Methodology to obtain the specified goals Additionally, the Medical Center formed two internal response teams to focus on tobacco use cessation and reducing childhood obesity. Both of these teams are collaborating with several local organizations such as the Boys and Girls Club and the Health Department.

Part VI, Line 3 The Medical Center posts notices of charity care in Admissions, the Emergency Department, Financial Services, and on the Promise Regional website Patients are given a written notice indicating the policy at the time of their admission via the Conditions of Admission form. In case of an emergency, the patient will be notified as soon as possible of the existence of charity care. English translation of this notice will be made available to Spanish-speaking patients. The Medical Center has trained front line staff to answer charity care questions or direct such questions to the appropriate party. Written information regarding the Medical Center's charity care policy as well as other payment options will be made available to any person who requests such information via mail, phone or in person

Part VI, Line 4 Promise Regional Medical Center is located in Reno County, Kansas in the city of Hutchinson. Reno County has an approximate population of 64,500 residents with population being 68% urban residents and 32% rural residents. The estimated average annual household income is \$39,000. Approximately 11% of the population is below the federal poverty annual income level. Of those individuals approximately 14% are under the age of 18 and 9% are 65 or over. Medicare services account for approximately 55% of all of the Medical Center's gross revenue, while Medical and self-pay services account for approximately 12% of the Medical Centers gross revenue. Promise Regional Medical Center is the only community based hospital in Reno County and is governed by a Board of Directors in which new members are nominated and selected from the community at large. The Medical Center is deeply invested in the quality of health care deliver and community well-being. Promise Regional Medical Center aims to be the first and best choice for health care in the surrounding region. Other medical facilities surrounding the Medical Center are located in Halstead, Moundridge, and McPherson. The distances between the Medical Center and these facilities are 23, 24, and 26 miles respectively. There are also two large medical facilities located in Wichita and are approximately 53 and 54 miles away.

Part VI, Line 5 At this time, Promise Regional Medical Center does not have programs that directly address the root causes of health problems, however the management team is (as a part of their job description) required to participate in community volunteer activities that focus on these issues As of this writing, members of the management team currently serve on the following notable local, state, and national boards and committees Reno County Cancer Council Red Cross Board Hutchinson Area Student Services Health Clinic American Red Cross, Hutchinson Chapter American Heart Association-Flint Hills Division Board of Directors Executive Leadership Team for Hutchinson Heart Walk Health Strategies/Life Strategies Foundation Board of Directors Kansas Health Ethics Board Arthritis Foundation (Kansas/Missouri chapter) Hospice & Home Care of Reno County Reno County Transportation Committee Hutchinson Community College Associate Degree Nursing Program Advisory Committee Hutchinson Community College-RHIT Advisory Board AmbucsMany of these boards and committees have a direct and/or indirect impact on the root causes of health issues in our county and surrounding area

Part VI, Line 6 Promise Regional Medical Center is the only community based hospital in Reno County and is governed by a Board of Directors which new members are nominated and selected from the community at large Corporation By-Laws state "It is the intent and purpose of these By-Laws that the members of the Board shall constitute a balance representation of the community and the Medical Staff" The board meets monthly with the purpose of guiding the Medical Center and assuring quality medical care for all patients regardless of their ability to pay for services Medical Staff privileges are granted by a combined vote of the Medical Executive Committee and Promise Regional Medical Center's Board of Directors Qualified physicians from Reno County and the surrounding area are encouraged to apply for privileges and are only rejected for licensure or other issues related to quality of care or moral character All surplus funds are applied towards investments in plant or equipment to provide state of the art care in the most modern, patient friendly environment possible.
