Bylaws
Friends of the Fairfield Public Library, Inc.
(As Amended on September 30, 2009)

Article I

Mission

To enhance the partnership between the Fairfield Public Library and the community to advocate for quality library service for all of the people of the Town of Fairfield.

Article II

Name

The Friends of the Fairfield Public Library, Inc.

Article III

Purpose

Section 1.

To maintain an association of persons interested in the Library:

- a) To foster closer relations between the Fairfield Public Library and the community of the Town of Fairfield;
- b) To focus public attention in a positive manner on library services, facilities, resources, functions, and needs;
- c) To help promote the use and enjoyment of the Library as a center for lifelong learning and a community hub;
- d) To foster public support and aid in the raising of supplemental funds for necessary development of the Library to serve the community;
- e) To support services, programs and events for the community that are compatible with the Library's policies and objectives.

Section 2.

It is recognized that the administration of the Fairfield Public Library is vested in the Town of Fairfield, the Board of Library Trustees and the Town Librarian.

Article IV

Membership

Section 1.

Membership in the Friends of the Fairfield Public Library shall be open to individuals, organizations, and businesses that value the services of the Fairfield Public Library.

Section 2.

The Board of Directors may establish various categories of membership and dues for each. Examples of such categories could include but are not limited to basic individual, family, student, senior, business, organization, and Fairfield Public Library employees.

Section 3.

Each individual member and a representative of each organization and business, in good standing, shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote at any meeting of the members.

Article V

Officers and Committees

Section 1.

The officers of this association shall be President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The officers of the association, along with at least three members-at-large, shall be known as the Board of Directors, and shall be the governing body of this association. Officers and members-at-large must be members of the association. The Board of Directors shall be elected by a majority vote of those present at the annual meeting for a term of one year. No member of the Board of Directors may serve in one position for more than three consecutive one year terms, except for the Treasurer, who, upon majority vote of the remaining Board members, may serve for more than three consecutive one year terms. The remaining Board members shall vote each year to determine whether the Treasurer shall continue in his/her position for the following year. The Town Librarian, or designee, shall be an ex-officio member of the Board of Directors.

Section 2.

The duties and responsibilities of the officers shall be as follows:

- a) The President shall preside at all meetings, represent the association when appropriate, and serve as ex-officio member of all committees except Nominating. This person shall direct the administration of the business of the association. The President, or designee, shall attend the meetings of the Board of Trustees of the Fairfield Public Library.
- b) The Vice President shall preside in the absence of the President and shall perform such duties as requested by the President. In the event of the resignation, incapacitation or death of the President, the Vice-President shall then become President for the remainder of that term of office.
- c) The Secretary shall keep a correct record of meetings of the organization and shall prepare correspondence as required, including distribution of the minutes of meetings to the Board of Directors.
- d) The Treasurer shall be responsible for maintaining an accurate record of all funds received and disbursed, collect dues and other revenues, disburse funds, and submit a statement to date at each meeting of the Board of Directors.
- e) The Board of Directors shall administer all funds of the association.

Section 3.

The Board of Directors shall have the authority to appoint committees consistent with the purpose of the organization and to appoint committee chairpersons.

Section 4.

Vacancies arising on the Board of Directors shall be filled by simple majority vote of the remaining Board of Directors. Interim Board members shall serve until the next election.

Section 5.

Nomination for officers and members-at-large shall be presented by a Nominating Committee of three, to be appointed by the Board of Directors. One member of the Nominating Committee must be a member of the current Board of Directors. At the annual meeting, nominations from the floor will be invited, with consent of the nominee.

Article VI
Meetings

Section 1.

This association shall hold its Annual Meeting in September for the purpose of election of a Board of Directors, to receive various reports, and to enact any other business. Public notice shall be made prior to the meeting.

Section 2.

Additional meetings shall be scheduled as recommended by either special committees, the President or the Board of Directors, and approved by the Board of Directors.

Section 3.

The Board of Directors shall meet at least quarterly and at other times as needed, upon the call of the President. A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum.

Section 4.

All proceedings of this association shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order, Revised.

Article VII
Dues

Section 1.

The rate of dues for each category of membership shall be set annually, upon recommendation of the Board of Directors and subject to approval of the general membership at the Annual Meeting.

Article VIII
Finances

Section 1.

The Treasurer shall maintain and be responsible for the adequate books of account. General funds shall be deposited to the master account of The Friends of the Fairfield Public Library, Inc. and shall be disbursed by the Treasurer in accordance with the directives of the Board of Directors.

Section 2.

All checks shall be signed by the Treasurer and one other individual as designated by the Board of Directors.

Section 3.

The Board of Directors shall appoint an auditor, who is not an officer, to audit the Treasurer's books prior to the Annual Meeting. The audited Treasurer's report will be presented at the Annual Meeting.

Section 4.

The fiscal year of this association shall begin on July 1 of each year and end on June 30 of the following year.

Section 5.

No member of this association shall be liable except for unpaid dues; and no personal liability shall in any event be attached to any member in connection with any of its undertakings.

Section 6.

The liability of the Board of Directors is limited to compensation received from the association for such service.

**Article IX
Amendments**

These bylaws may be amended on prior notice at any meeting of the general membership, by a two-thirds vote of the members present, provided that prior public notice of the proposed change was provided.

**Article X
Dissolution**

This association is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. No part of the net earnings shall inure to the benefit of private shareholders or individuals. Upon dissolution, assets will be distributed to the Fairfield Public Library. If the Library is unable, unwilling, or ineligible to receive the assets, they will be distributed to the State of Connecticut or to a municipality for the public purpose or to an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
