The average student growth was over 35 percentile points for the 122 children with pre and post Dial-3 scores in the classrooms running the entire school year. The average Dial-3 assessment score for the children when they entered the More at four Program was 36% and the average score when they completed the school year was 72%. In addition, 33% of the children scored 90% or higher on the post Dial-3 assessment.

There were 56 child care referrals made, 150 baby bags given out, 162 child care providers that attended trainings, and 675 Kindergarten Readiness boxes distributed. There were 79 children and families who participated in a weekly playgroup, 4 child care facilities who participated in technical assistance activities designed to increase their star rating to 3-star or higher, 8 child care facilities who participated in technical assistance activities designed to maintain their current star rating of 3-star or higher. 9 expectant or new mothers benefited from the breast pump loaner program, 40 car seat checks were done, and 237 items were checked out of the lending library. A total of 22 child care homes and 17 child care centers were served. A total of 560 children ages 0-5 benefited from services.

Consultations include review and training on health policies and procedures, health/developmental screenings on a limited basis based on child care provider concern or if Child Care Health Consultant observation indicates a need, review of immunizations, and educational programs/trainings to providers, children and parents. 48 facilities received on-site consultations, 106 child care providers participated in the trainings, 26 child care facilities participated in the trainings, and 1570 immunization audits completed. Also, evaluations completed by the training attendees indicated that 99% of them reported that the training provided them with new knowledge and skills on health and safety issues.
