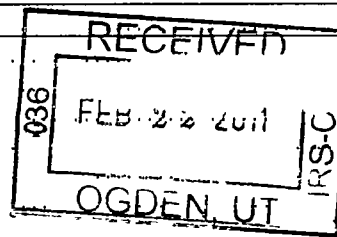

Management expects that the mission of the Institute will be attractive to government funders, and is actively seeking government grants (not contracts). Management is also seeking to diversify the individual donor base, such that a smaller portion of the Institute's total contributions will be from its current core donor pool.
