The University regularly reviews and evaluates its tax positions taken in previously filed information returns and as reflected in its financial statements, with regard to issues affecting its tax exempt status, unrelated business income and related matters. Management believes that in the event of an examination by taxing authorities, its positions would prevail based upon the technical merits of such positions. Therefore, the University has concluded that no tax benefits or liabilities are required to be recognized. Generally, the IRS may examine a tax return for three years from the date it is filed. At June 30, 2010, tax years ended June 30, 2009, and 2008, and 2007 remain open for possible examination by the IRS.
