The best available data was used to calculate the amounts reported in the table. For the information in the table, a cost-to-charge ratio were calculated and applied.

Part III, Line 4. The provision for bad debts is based upon management's assessment of expected net collections considering economic conditions, historical experience, trends in health care coverage, and other collection indicators. Periodically throughout the year, management assesses the adequacy of allowance for uncollectible accounts based upon historical write off experience by payor category, including those amounts no covered by insurance. The results of this review are then used to make any modifications to the provision for bad debts to establish an appropriate allowance for uncollectible accounts. After satisfaction of amounts due from insurance and reasonable efforts to collect from the patient have been exhausted, the organization follows established guidelines for placing certain past due patient balances with collection agencies, subject to the terms of certain restrictions on collection efforts as determined by the organization. Accounts receivable are written off after collection efforts have been followed in accordance with the Organization's policies. The cost of charge ratio was used to determine the bad debt expense at cost. Bad debt expense at cost attributable to patients eligible under the organization's charity polity was calculated by using the US Census date to determine the percentage of population below 200% of the FPL and applied that percentage to bad debt expense at cost as an estimate of charity in bad debt.

Part III, Line 8 Ascension Health and related health ministries follow the Catholic Health Association ("CHA") guidelines for determining community benefit CHA community benefit reporting guidelines suggest that Medicare shortfall is not treated as community benefit. The cost to charge ratio method is used in determining the shortfall.

Part III, Line 9b St Vincent's Health System follows the Ascension guidelines for collection practices related to patients qualifying for charity or financial assistance at any time during the collection cycle. Once qualifying documentation is received the patient's account is adjusted off. Patient accounts for the qualifying patient in the previous six months may also be considered for charity or financial assistance. Once a patient qualifies for charity or financial assistance, all collection activity is suspended.

The assessment was completed by interviewing key stakeholders both within St Vincents Health Care system and in the external community. With the assistance of magnification, and adaptations of the special low vision aids that are useful for certain daily tasks, the visually impaired person can function with less difficulty. The Vision Center provides services for the person with low vision. These services are designed to benefit a person's daily life activities, which may be hindered by the visual loss St. Vincent's Birmingham Jeremiah's Hope Skills Program focuses on training at-risk individuals, particularly women, for entry level jobs in the healthcare industry. Today, more than 300 people have graduated from Jeremiah's Hope, and most are still working in the healthcare industry St Vincent's has also recently partnered with Jeff State Commun ity College to begin identifying "under-employed" individuals from within our own workforc e and training them to become nurses Philanthropy allowed this revolutionary program to b lossom and it has now become a model for other healthcare facilities nationwide In 2003.
