Huntsville Hospital Foundation was established in 1978 as the 501 (c)(3) non-profit fundraising arm of Huntsville Hospital, also a not-for-profit entity. Huntsville Hospital, established in 1895, has grown to be the regional tertiary care center for north Alabama and south central Tennessee, and is the ninth largest publicly-owned hospital in the country with 881 licensed acute care beds, and more than 650 physicians who are supported by 6,000 hospital employees. In fiscal year 2010, we admitted 42,366 patients, treated 554,687 outpatients, and provided more than \$72.1 million in uncompensated medical care.

The hospital provides quality, leading-edge healthcare to a service area of more than 1.1 million people, regardless of their ability to pay. We provide the area's only regional trauma program and the busiest Emergency Department in the state of Alabama, cardiovascular services (largest Cath Lab in the state of Alabama, and cardiovascular surgery program which is ranked in the top 10% in the nation), primary stroke center designation, Joint Camp (nationally recognized joint replacement program), perfect rating for the Mammography program, approved Oncology program with commendation, and exceptional Lab accreditation.

Huntsville Hospital for Women and Children is home to the only full-service Pediatric Unit, Pediatric Emergency Department, Pediatric ICU, and the only Level III Neonatal ICU between Birmingham and Nashville. The hospital also houses one of only six St. Jude affiliate clinics in the country.

The hospital system's facilities include Huntsville Hospital, Huntsville Hospital for Women & Children, an outpatient Medical Mall, Madison Medical Park and a 70-bed rehabilitation hospital located on the campus. The 60-bed Madison Hospital is scheduled to open in February 2012.

As a not-for-profit hospital that receives no tax support from city, state or federal governments, Huntsville Hospital relies on philanthropy to fund its capital and operational needs. The Huntsville Hospital Foundation accepts charitable contributions on the hospital's behalf and works to fund both present and future equipment and program needs. Contributions of any amount are gratefully accepted and may be unrestricted gifts or designated for a specific hospital unit or program. Contributions to the Foundation are tax deductible, with 100% of all gifts benefiting the hospital program or department designated by its donors.

Huntsville Hospital Foundation's mission is to develop relationships and financial resources to support the healthcare programs, projects and services of Huntsville Hospital. Additionally, Health Teacher, an innovative online health education program for Grades K-12, is provided free of charge by the Foundation to students in 5 north Alabama counties.

Although Huntsville Hospital is a regional healthcare facility, it is very much a community hospital. The Foundation staff strives to involve anyone who wishes to support the hospital with gifts of time, talent and resources: from the 5-year old child who swims laps and raises funds for the Neonatal ICU, to the teen Leadership Council member who volunteers her time, to the young professional who serves in an advocacy role through membership in the Foundation's Development Council, to the Baby Boomer who chairs an event committee or makes a significant charitable contribution that provides a piece of lifesaving technology. Each gift is invaluable and appreciated; and our staff, volunteers and donors join hands to support this crown jewel in our community.

Stewardship, accountability and transparency are our watchwords, for we know that we serve the community through our work at the Foundation. Donations may be restricted to a particular hospital department or program, or they may be given to the area of greatest need. Regardless, 100% of each gift (with the exception of special event donations) benefits the area designated by the donor because Huntsville Hospital covers the overhead expenses of the Foundation.

Huntsville Hospital is a partnership of people who care. Originally built through generous community volunteerism and contributions, this care has extended to generations of families in the Tennessee Valley since 1895. Now more than ever, Huntsville Hospital relies on philanthropy to meet the healthcare needs of the region. Thousands of individuals, clubs, schools, local businesses and national corporations have joined together to support excellence in healthcare for north Alabama. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, Huntsville Hospital Foundation provided record funding for Huntsville Hospital and its patients in fiscal year 2009. The Foundation manages more than 300 designated funds representing virtually every department and nursing unit at the hospital, and distributes funds as needed to provide cutting-edge technology and lifesaving programs that otherwise would not be possible. Philanthropy provided \$2,647,433 to fund equipment and program needs. The balance of the funds raised was transferred to the Foundation's general endowment which will provide for Huntsville Hospital into perpetuity.

In fiscal year 2010, the Foundation provided \$814,445 (45% of the total funds distributed) to Huntsville Hospital for Women & Children. Examples of programs provided, and equipment purchased, thanks to philanthropy included: (1) the establishment of a Pediatric Audiology Program for Pediatric Therapy – a new center for hearing-impaired children and those with cochlear implants. Children can now receive diagnostic testing and appropriate follow-up treatment locally rather than having to travel to Birmingham or Nashville; (2) Glidescope Video Intubation Tool for Pediatric ICU – uses fiber optics to visualize difficult airways in young children; (3) Ultrasound System for the Breast Center – features a high frequency transducer that gives superior resolution and detail, and can actually detect calcifications. Even small cancers can be diagnosed with this technology; (4) three Giraffe Incubators and a Giraffe Omnibed for the Neonatal ICU – provides the best in technology for critically ill newborns, offering thermoregulation and shielding babies from light and sound that could disrupt their growth; (5) preliminary funding for Breast Specific Gamma Imaging (BSGI) – provides an image for the radiologist to

compare to the mammogram or MRI. The BSGI views the metabolism of cancerous lesions in the breast via radiopharmaceutical update. The Foundation will complete funding of this technology in fiscal year 2011; (6) full funding of a music therapy program in the Pediatric Therapy department; (7) toys, games and activities for the Child Life program; (8) celebration parties for patients who complete their chemotherapy treatment at Huntsville Hospital's St. Jude Affiliate Clinic; (9) a Horticulture Therapy Garden/Deck for our Pediatric Therapy patients.

The Foundation provided \$177,644 (10% of the total funds distributed) for the Cath Lab and various departments in the Cardiology Services service line. Examples of equipment provided by philanthropy: (1) an Intracardiac Ultrasound System for the Cath Lab - cutting-edge technology utilized in treating patients with ASD (atrial septal defect, or "hole in the heart"). An ultrasound probe is threaded into the heart via femoral venous access and allows for a closer and more detailed view; (2) two Ultrafiltration Machines for Cardiology II & Congestive Heart Failure Clinic - removes fluid from the body when a patient is in volume overload related to heart failure, and when diuretic therapy has failed; (3) a Hypothermia System for the Emergency Department/Cardiology - cools the body to prevent brain damage and other major organ damage in cardiac arrest patients; (4) a Lifepak Monitor & Defibrillator for the First Heart Critical Transport Ambulance - utilized during emergency transfer of cardiac patients to Huntsville Hospital. The monitor records patient vital signs which can be transmitted to a physician in the Emergency Department, and defibrillation technology is available if needed; (5) Stress Exercise System.

FORM 990. PART III, LINE 4c – OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM SERVICE ACCOMPLISHMENTS: PATHOLOGY LAB AND RADIOLOGY DEPARTMENT:

The Foundation provided \$118,848 (7% of the total funds distributed) for the Pathology Lab and Radiology department. Examples of philanthropy-provided equipment include: (1) Cobas Post-Analytical Storage & Retrieval System for the Pathology Lab – a robotic and automated system that archives and stores all lab specimens after they are tested, and can retrieve the sample if needed for later use; (2) a ProVis Injector for Radiology - a vascular injection system that is utilized for diagnostic and interventional procedures; the injection system delivers contrast reliably, easily and safely; and produces high quality images.

The balance of philanthropy funding (\$700,128) provided cutting-edge technology and programs such as the following: (1) 28 Vein Viewers for Nursing Units throughout the hospital – use infra-red light to illuminate and better locate veins, thus alleviating the pain of multiple needle sticks for patients; (2) cutting edge Marti Interpreter Systems utilized hospital-wide; the system provides live video/audio interpretation which gives staff, patients and family members instant access to interpreters of 150 languages, as well as American Sign Language for deaf patients; (3) HealthTeacher, an Internet-based health education curriculum provided free for teachers and students in grades K-12 in five north Alabama counties; (4) medication assistance for cancer patients and Cardiac Rehab assistance for heart patients....and much, much more.
