Please accept our thanks for your gracious contribution to the Menil made in FY 2010. As stated above, your gift was dedicated to the museum's general operations and was one of those extremely valuable in helping us meet our FY10 expenses. Thank you for your ongoing generosity to the Menil Our records show that the Adler Foundation and you as individuals have supported this institution annually since 1988, and for this generosity, we are grateful.

This letter is intended to satisfy the responsibility of the Menil Foundation, Inc. ("Menil") for reporting to the The Adler Foundation for the above-referenced grant received in fiscal year 2010 Please be assured that the grant funds were used solely for the support of general museum operations.

For the fiscal year ended June 30, 2010, the Menil's revenues from all sources, both restricted and unrestricted, were \$15.5 million, excluding unrealized gains and losses from investments, works of art and additions to the permanent endowments. Of this total revenue, \$11.2 million was specifically designated for the operations of the Menil. Ongoing operations of the Menil incurred expenditures of \$15.3 million during the same period including art acquisitions and capital equipment

In addition to exhibiting selections from its world-renowned permanent collection of art, The Menil Collection presented diverse special exhibitions and public programs during the grant period. Of the eyer-increasing number of people who visited the museum this year, many came from out of state as well as from Latin America, Europe and Asia.

Among the year's exhibition highlights were: Body in Fragments (August 2009 - February 2010); Cy Twombly: Treatise on the Veil (October 2009 - February 2010); Maurizio Cattelan (February - August 2010); Leaps into the Void: Documents of Nouveau Réalist Performance (March - August 2010); and Steve Wolfe on Paper (April - July 2010). Public programs included The Artist's Eye Series (first Sunday of each month), museum tours, gallery talks, symposiums, readings and lectures For members, more than forty programs and tours were offered, enabling participants opportunities to learn in depth about the museum's holdings, exhibitions, and relationships with artists. For children, Writing at the Menil celebrated its 22nd year, bringing children from disadvantaged backgrounds to the museum to look and to write about the art here. A partnership with Writers in the School, the program reaches approximately 5,000 children each year, primarily from Title One schools in and around Houston

As a part of this report, a copy of the audited financial statements for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2010 (July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010) prepared by Deloitte and Touche LLP for the Menil Foundation Inc is enclosed
