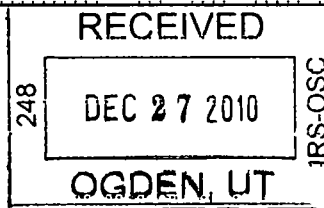

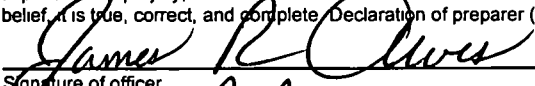

The mission of the organization is to provide community leadership for the development and active use of the park through education, advocacy and stewardship. In addition to working with numerous governmental agencies and providing a citizen perspective on development issues, the Friends promote awareness and community participation by providing educational and outreach programs and volunteer opportunities.

Statement 6 - Form 990-EZ, Part III, Line 28 - Statement of Program Service Accomplishments**Description**

Friends of Guadalupe River Park & Gardens (Friends of GRPG) was formed in 1995 and has grown from a volunteer-run organization to an established community nonprofit that is recognized for coordinating the opening celebration for the river park in 2005, operating the Visitor & Education Center for park visitors, advocating for trails and other improvements, and offering a comprehensive array of educational programs and events that promote environmental stewardship and park use.

Additionally, Friends of GRPG recruits, trains, and supports hundreds of volunteers each year who maintain the Heritage Rose Garden, a Historic Orchard, and other gardens in Guadalupe Gardens; organize river clean-ups; staff events, and provide interpretive tours of the park for visitors.

Guadalupe River Park & Gardens is uniquely situated along the river in downtown San Jose and features miles of riparian habitat, hiking and biking trails, and botanical gardens. The geographic location and features of the park make it an ideal site for introducing children to nature in the midst of an urban environment.

During FY 09/10, our education program had 3,697 participants, including more than 3,000 elementary-school students who experienced one of our hands-on nature education field trips. Field trips are tied to state education standards and use the park as a natural learning environment. Children also participated in our monthly after-school workshops, and 300 3rd grade students joined us for our annual Water Wizard Festival. Adult offerings included fitness classes, gardening, and nature-related crafts. During the year ended June 30, 2010, Friends of GRPG held two free community festivals - Pumpkins in the Park and Spring in Guadalupe Gardens, which drew over 20,000 people to the park. Additional park advocacy activities included participation in a single-use bag ban stakeholder group and master planning for Guadalupe Gardens. The bulk of the 11,589 volunteer hours logged during the year were devoted to maintenance of the Heritage Rose Garden, Historic Orchard and other gardens. In addition to coordinating one-time or ongoing individual volunteers, Friends of GRPG worked with 39 corporate work groups from Adobe, Cisco, Deloitte, Intel, Applied Materials and other companies to provide service projects in the park.

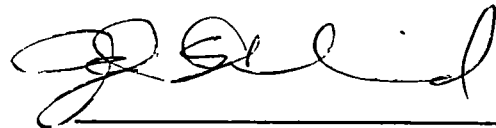
