

**About the Foundation and its Mission**

The Foundation for Excellence (FFE) has established a Scholarship Program to enable academically brilliant and financially needy students in India to continue and complete their education. Under the program, financial and other assistance is provided to eligible and deserving students.

**Volunteer Coordinators and Facilitators**

The Foundation accomplishes its mission through a network of volunteers in the US and in India. The US based volunteers are referred to as "coordinators" while the India based volunteers are referred to as "facilitators".

Coordinators are US citizens and permanent residents while facilitators are persons resident in India. Currently, more than 300 coordinators and 1,000 facilitators are enrolled with the Foundation.

The main role of a coordinator is to identify persons in India who are known to the coordinator and who are agreeable to volunteer their time and effort in implementing the programs of the Foundation in India. The main roles of a facilitator are to identify and sponsor students in India who qualify for the scholarship program, assist the student in completing and submitting the scholarship application form and to facilitate the disbursement of the approved scholarship funds.

Coordinators and facilitators are not permitted to recommend any of their relatives for the Scholarship Program.

**The Scholarship Program**

The Scholarship Program is available to students from all over India for their studies in India. Scholarships are awarded solely on the basis of academic eligibility and financial need. No discrimination is made on the basis of caste, gender, religion, and region. Scholarships are directly awarded and paid to the student. Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis. Renewal of a scholarship is dependent on continued academic excellence and financial need.

To be eligible for a scholarship, an applicant must meet five requirements:

- Study at an approved educational institution and for an eligible course.
- Meet specified criteria for academic excellence.
- Demonstrate financial need based on family background and income.
- Must have incurred or expect to incur eligible expenses.

Students wishing to be considered for a scholarship need to submit an application through an authorized facilitator.

### **Review and Approval of Scholarship Applications**

Scholarship applications are received at the Foundation's office in Bengaluru, India. After initial administrative scrutiny, eligible applications are submitted to an independent Scholarship Review Committee. Scholarships are approved and awarded based on the Committee's recommendations. Procedures are in place to ensure that neither the members of the Committee nor the coordinators and facilitators are in a position to receive a private benefit, directly or indirectly, as a result of certain potential grantees being selected over others for the award of scholarships.

Applicants awarded scholarships are required to send an acknowledgement within 30 days of the receipt of the grant. They are also expected to confirm that they have used the grant to meet the expenses connected with their education and approved course of study and to support such use with proper receipts. When it is determined that the student has not sent an acknowledgment despite receipt of a grant, or when the grant is not used for the purpose for which it was given, or where the grant is not fully used, steps are taken through the respective coordinator and facilitator for the recovery of the entire or partial amount from the applicant or his parents/guardian. The Foundation may also suspend the student from applying for a grant in the future.

**Grants to Individual Recipients**

The Foundation maintains individual files for each applicant. Each student file includes the following records: application form with all attachments - grade transcripts, marks sheets, family income particulars, statements of estimated expense requirements, receipts of actual expenses incurred by the applicant - required to evaluate the grantee's eligibility, the Scholarship Review Committee's review form for the student including a recommendation for the award of scholarship, scholarship payment authorization and check particulars, and the acknowledgement receipt from the student. Where applicable, the student file includes records of any investigation in to the use of the grant and subsequent action taken by the Foundation.

The use of the grant funds are also audited by an independent accountant.
