Serving Central Wyoming, the coalition is comprised of almost 50 individuals who represent law enforcement, safety and health advocates, parents and grandparents, education professionals, child advocate groups, city and county officials. Every year, a Safe Kids Day is held where more than 1,000 participants enjoy a day of fun and learning in an interactive environment. More than 800 helmets are distributed, 400 car seats are checked with more than 100 distributed, over 100 life jackets are distributed to children and families on an annual basis. Monthly car seat checks, bike rodeos, booster seat demonstrations in elementary schools, seat belt campaigns at the junior and senior high levels are routine calendar items. Involvement to prevent drunk driving is continual in an effort to protect children and their families.
