	in behalf of abused children. The CJC is to reduce trauma to child victims by facilitating the criminal justice response & therapy access with a multidisciplinary team in a safe child-friendly facility known as the Children's Justice Center.

4a	(Code:) (Expenses \$ 50,198.57 including grants of \$ 50,198.57) (Revenue \$ 0) The Friends of Utah County Children's Justice Center paid grants of \$50,198.57 for outpatient mental health therapy in behalf of more than 363 child abuse victims and directly impacted non-offending family members. These grants were paid directly to community mental health treatment providers for LMI families that would otherwise not receive needed therapy for the child abuse that they suffered. Additionally, this amount was significantly leveraged to serve as many children as possible through the donation of these therapists of services at 50% of the normal fee for these services.
4b	(Code:) (Expenses \$ 31,527.24 including grants of \$ 10,567.26) (Revenue \$ 0) The Friends of Utah County Children's Justice Center paid grants totaling \$10,567.26 to the Utah County Children's Justice Center to directly support the Children's Justice Center Program (part of Utah County Government). These grants included \$1,965.52 to replace equipment for conducting child abuse interviews and \$8,601.74 for supplies and expenses to directly serve child abuse victims. (Additional non cash community donated supplies and materials for child services and CJC Program volunteer services had an estimated value of more than \$45,000.00, making a significant contribution.) Additionally, the Friends of Utah County Children's Justice Center provide the community donated child-friendly facility that is fully provided to the Utah County Children's Justice Center Program to serve child abuse victims and their families. The cost for this land, building, and significant building addition is totally donated for the use of the CJC Program, which is a part of Utah County Government. Depreciation expenses for this facility were \$20,959.98 for the 2009 fiscal year.
