



STATEMENT OF PROGRAM SERVICE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

THE RIVER EXCHANGE IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION LOCATED IN DUNSMUIR, CALIFORNIA THAT PROMOTES HEALTHY WATERSHEDS IN THE SURROUNDING AREA THROUGH COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN STEWARDSHIP, RESTORATION AND EDUCATION. WE PROACTIVELY SUPPORT AND IMPROVE THE HEALTH OF THE WATERSHED ECOSYSTEM, EDUCATE AND EMPOWER THE COMMUNITY TO BE EFFECTIVE WATERSHED STEWARDS, AND FACILITATE COOPERATION OF STAKEHOLDERS IN COLLABORATIVE WATERSHED MANAGEMENT. THE ORGANIZATION BEGAN AS A PROJECT OF THE CITY OF DUNSMUIR IN 1996, CREATED IN THE AFTERMATH OF THE DISASTROUS CANTARA LOOP RAILROAD SPILL THAT DESTROYED ALL PLANT AND ANIMAL LIFE ALONG A THIRTY-SIX MILE STRETCH OF THE UPPER SACRAMENTO RIVER. SINCE THAT TIME, WE HAVE GROWN INTO AN INDEPENDENT AND SELF-SUSTAINING ORGANIZATION. ALONG THE WAY, WE HAVE TAUGHT THOUSANDS OF SCHOOLCHILDREN ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF HEALTHY WATERSHEDS, FOSTERING THE NEXT GENERATION OF RIVER STEWARDS. EACH YEAR THE RIVER EXCHANGE HOSTS THE GREAT RIVER CLEAN-UP IN THE FALL, INVOLVING THE COMMUNITY IN CLEANING UP DEBRIS LEFT BY RIVER USERS AND TEACHING THE IMPORTANCE OF STEWARDSHIP. IN THE SPRING, THE RIVER CELEBRATION BRINGS TOGETHER THE COMMUNITY IN SUPPORT OF HEALTHY WATERSHEDS. WE ARE MAJOR SPONSORS OF DUNSMUIR'S ANNUAL RIVER FESTIVAL, PLUS WE PROVIDE A SERIES OF INFORMATIONAL LECTURES ON WATERSHED SUSTAINABILITY.

WE HAVE DESIGNED AND IMPLEMENTED SEVERAL RIPARIAN RESTORATION AND TRAIL PROJECTS, INCLUDING RESTORATION OF THE SPRING AT THE HEADWATERS OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER IN THE CITY OF MOUNT SHASTA. WE ORGANIZED COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION FOR A MAJOR RESTORATION EFFORT ON TROUT CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF THE MCCLLOUD RIVER. WE COOPERATED WITH THE US FOREST SERVICE TO COMPLETE A RECREATION INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS FOR THE CASTLE CRAGS WILDERNESS AREA - USED FOR MANAGEMENT DECISIONS IMPACTING TRIBUTARIES OF THE UPPER SACRAMENTO RIVER. IN 2009, WE COMPLETED A MAPPING PROJECT AND STUDY OF SPRING RESTORATION POSSIBILITIES IN THE UPPER MCCLLOUD WATERSHED AND RECEIVED ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO DESIGN TWO PILOT SPRING RESTORATION PROJECTS, ONE ON PRIVATE LAND AND ONE ON PUBLIC LAND. IN JUNE 2010, THE UPPER SACRAMENTO WATERSHED ASSESSMENT WAS COMPLETED WITH PARTICIPATION OF A DIVERSE GROUP OF STAKEHOLDERS LED BY THE RIVER EXCHANGE. OUR ORGANIZATION IS ALSO LEADING THE REGIONAL WATER MANAGEMENT GROUP FOR THE UPPER SACRAMENTO/MCCLLOUD/LOWER PIT REGION, COOPERATING TO ADDRESS THE HIGHEST PRIORITY WATER NEEDS IN THE REGION.

OUR MEMBERS LIVE THROUGHOUT CALIFORNIA AND OTHER STATES. THEY SHARE A COMMON DESIRE TO SEE THE SPECTACULAR RIVERS AND WATERSHEDS OF FAR NORTHERN CALIFORNIA REMAIN HEALTHY AND PRODUCTIVE - SUSTAINED FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS TO ENJOY.
