|    | MARKETINGThe Marketing Department is charged with the strategic development of creative concepts for print, radio, TV, web and other emerging media vehicl Strategic media planning, placement and management in support of the foundation's counter-marketing mission also fall under the department's responsibilities Marketing manages all outside agencies in the support of these activities and develops grassroots, collateral, promotional and special event initiatives as complementary and integrated tactics. The foundation has perhaps been most widely recognized for its extremely effective youth-focused public education and prevention campaign called truth. Truth is the only national youth smoking prevention campaign in the country and has helped reduce youth smoking rates. In addition to youth prevention, the Marketing department focuses on adult cessation. The foundation recently launched EX, the only national cessation campaign in funded by the tobacco industry. EX equips smokers with everything they need to know to beat their addiction to tobacco. |

Each grant or contract aims to affect one or more of the foundation's goals. In February, 2009, Legacy's Board of Directors made a decision to discontinue its national calls for proposals for the grant-making program, with the last cycle awarded in Summer, 2009. All current existing grants will be support until the grant has ended, per contractual agreement. The Foundation will continue to provide directed grant making on a very limited basis.   |

The team conducts several national surveys to monitor tobacco-related knowledge, attitudes, beliefs, and behaviors among youth and adults in the United State. To ensure the highest level of credibility, research staff substantiate all factual information for all departments within the Foundation. By developing peer-review publications as well as brief reports written for both specific audiences and the general public, the team contributes to advancing the scientific knowledge base related to tobacco control.
