## Note to 2009 Form 990-PF for Kalmanovitz Charitable Foundation (EIN 94-6760317) (IRC Section 6033(h) and Other Reporting)

The Kalmanovitz Charitable Foundation ("Foundation") acquired 100% of the shares ("Shares") of S & P Company ("Company") in July of 2000. Prior thereto those Shares were owned by Paul and Lydia Kalmanovitz or their respective estates.

Since before 2000, the Company has suffered significant operating losses in one of its subsidiaries (with respect to which a consolidated return is filed) and by the end of FY 2009, there were no current or accumulated "earnings and profits" ("CAEP"). Nevertheless, during the course of FY 2009, the Company distributed \$8,112,000 to the Foundation (see Part III, Line 3). Because of the lack of CAEP, the distributions were treated as a non-taxable return of capital, reducing the tax basis in the shares of the Company owned by the Foundation (but not reducing the "net unrelated income" of the Company). Because of the post-death but pre-2000 losses, the "book value" of the shares has been substantially less than their "adjusted tax basis" in the hands of the Foundation. However, because the distributions may be a "transfer of funds" within the meaning of IRC Section 6033(h)(3), those distributions are hereby being disclosed even though a "dividend" or a "return of capital" would seem to be beyond the concept. No loans or other transfer of funds were made by the Foundation to the Company.

The above-referenced subsidiary was the subject of a request to the IRS for an extension to June 30, 2010 of the time in which to dispose of the subsidiary in order to comply with the requirements of IRC §4943 (i.e., excess business holdings). The IRS granted the requested extension in its letter dated April 6, 2005.

Pursuant to the approved extension, renewed efforts were undertaken to dispose of the subsidiary. These efforts eventually resulted in an agreement to dispose of the subsidiary. The agreement was then submitted to the Charitable Trusts Section of the Office of the California Attorney General. In his letter dated May 24, 2010, the California Attorney General stated his "non-opposition to the proposed transaction". Before the June 30, 2010 deadline, the transaction was closed and the subsidiary was disposed of.
