THE HOURS DISCLOSED ARE THE ESTIMATED HOURS THE EMPLOYEE SPENDS SOLELY ON FOUNDATION BUSINESS. UC SAN DIEGO FOUNDATION EMPLOYEES ARE ALSO ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE UC RETIREMENT AND 403(B) PLANS WHICH ARE MANAGED BY THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA. SIMILARLY THE UC SAN DIEGO FOUNDATION'S OPERATING COSTS, SPACE AND FACILITY NEEDS ARE PROVIDED BY THE UC SAN DIEGO CAMPUS FREE OF CHARGE, AS ITS PRIMARY SUPPORTING ORGANIZATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA POLICY.

CONTRIBUTIONS

THE UC SAN DIEGO FOUNDATION SOLICITS GIFTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OFFICE OF THE UC SAN DIEGO CAMPUS, ITS FACULTY, AND ITS VOLUNTEERS.
