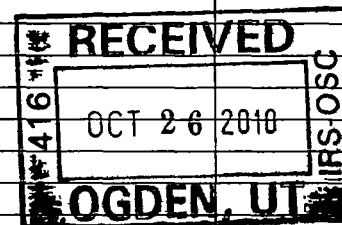

2c. Submission deadlines:

In order to be considered for grants made in June 2010, all proposals must be received by the Foundation Manager no later than December 12, 2009.

2d. Restrictions or limitations on awards:

Organizations soliciting funds from the Nissan Foundation or the planned project for which the organization is soliciting funds must take place where selected Nissan affiliates are located. These communities include South Central Los Angeles, Middle Tennessee, and South Central Mississippi.
