The Mission of the Alexandria Singers is to perform American popular and patriotic music; to inspire new generations of singers; to broaden our reach to include all ages within the American culture; and to celebrate this music by presenting it locally, nationally and abroad.

We believe music is essential to the human spirit and that singing promotes joy, fellowship, and understanding which transcends racial, ethnic, social, religious, and cultural barriers.

The Alexandria Singers is a non-profit, mixed voice choral group that performs predominately American popular music, including pop tunes, show tunes, golden oldies, country and jazz – the only one of its kind in the Washington DC area. Founded in 1975 by 16 people, the group has grown to more than 50 members. Singers range in age from 20 to 70 and hold a variety of jobs and interests. What they all have in common is their love of singing. The Alexandria Singers are sponsored by the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Over the last twenty years the Singers have performed in many places including the Kennedy Center, DAR Constitution Hall, the Alexandria Lyceum, the Mormon Visitor's Center and the George Washington Masonic Memorial. They also performed at various events including the Alexandria Red Cross Waterfront Festival, the WKYS Radio's Capitol City Music Festival, Christmas in Washington program for Ronald Regan, the Inaugural Songfest at the Kennedy Center for President-Elect Jimmy Carter, and the annual Christmas Eve benefit for the Salvation Army hosted by WMAL-FM. The Alexandria Singers have also joined other area musical groups in various concerts including the Alexandria Harmonizers, the Air Force Band, the Washington Symphonic Brass and Percussion Ensemble, the Arlington Symphony, the Mormon Choir of Washington and the Capitol Steps.

Bringing music to the community has always been an important part of the Singers' service. Each year the schedule includes concerts at area hospitals and nursing homes to reach those individuals that cannot attend our normal performances. They also perform free concerts at Market Square and Fort Ward Park every year. On occasion, you may even see the Singers performing in one of the metropolitan area malls.
