In 2010, subsequent to the release of the financial statements for 2009, the Club received notice of investigation from the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board regarding violations of the State's regulations on payout of profits from small games of chance during fiscal years 2009 and prior. In settlement of the investigation, the Club is required to make payments to local charities in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the proceeds of the Club's small games of chance for 2009 and prior fiscal years. Accordingly, the Club has restated its 2009 financial statements to accrue the \$1,000,000 contributions payable with the effect of decreasing the change in unrestricted members' equity for 2009 and the beginning unrestricted members' equity for 2010 by \$1,000,000. Accordingly, their net assets have also been changed on this Form 990 to reflect the \$1,000,000 decrease in the prior year ending net assets.
