<u>Line 28</u> – Bartholomew County Farm Bureau, Inc. promotes agriculture and youth involvement in agriculture through a number of activities and sponsorships at the county 4-H fair. At the fair, Bartholomew County Farm Bureau gives away free popcorn, provides free nightly entertainment to the public, purchases animals at the 4-H livestock auction, and sponsors various awards.

22 volunteers spent 47 hours planning, coordinating, and carrying out these activities.

The objectives of these activities are to promote agriculture and to strengthen relationships with local governing bodies.

Bartholomew County Farm Bureau, Inc. contributed \$4,775 for entertainment expenses, advertisements, livestock purchases, trophies, ribbons, and awards.

<u>Line 29</u> – Bartholomew County Farm Bureau, Inc. educates local schoolchildren about agriculture by participating in the Ag Day program as part of the Ag Expo. 94 volunteers spend 19 hours holding morning and afternoon informational sessions with fourth grade students. 875 students and 32 teachers were involved in this program.

The objective of this activity is to educate local children about agriculture.

Bartholomew County Farm Bureau, Inc. contributed \$1,044 for food and supplies for the Ag Day program.
