BY-LAWS

OF

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF COLUMBUS FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE I

Offices

The principal office of the corporation in the State of Nebraska shall be located at 2508 27 Street, in the City of Columbus, County of Platte. The corporation may have such other offices, either within or without the State of Nebraska as the Board of Directors may determine or as the affairs of the corporation may require from time to time. The corporation shall have and continuously maintain in the State of Nebraska a registered office, and a registered agent whose office is identical with such registered office, as required by the Nebraska Non-Profit Corporation Act. The registered office may be, but need not be, identical with the principal office in the State of Nebraska, and the address of the registered office may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors

ARTICLE II Members

The Corporation shall have no members. It shall be governed by a Board of Directors as hereinaster provided.

ARTICLE III Board of Directors

Section 1. General Powers. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors.

Section 2. Number, Tenure and Qualifications. The number of Directors shall be not less than 5 or more than 20. Each Director shall hold office for 3 years. In the event of a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to complete the term of office. The Superintendent of Schools of the Columbus School District shall be a non-voting member of the Board of Directors by virtue of his office. The Board of Education of the Columbus School District shall select two (2) members from its Board to serve on the Board of Directors of the Foundation. Whether standing for election to an open seat or appointed to fill a vacancy, individuals who are nominated to serve on the Board of Directors of the Foundation shall first be approved by the Board of Education of the Columbus School District.

Section 3. Regular Meetings. A regular annual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held without other notice than this By-Law, on the 4th Thursday of August each year. The Board of Directors may provide by resolution the time and place, either within or without the State of Nebraska, for the holding of additional regular meetings of the Board without other notice than such resolution. Directors may participate at any regular meeting by telephone in the same manner as if such Director was personally present at the meeting.

Section 4. Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by or at the request of the President or any two Directors. The person or persons authorized to call special meetings of the board may fix any place, either within or without the State of Nebraska, as the place for holding any special meeting of the Board called by them. A Director may participate at any Special Meeting by telephone in the same manner as if such Director was personally present at the meeting.

A special meeting may also be held via electronic means. Only a single issue may be addressed and voted upon by the Board of Directors via email communications. Should an email vote be requested, the President shall determine whether to submit the Motion to the Board of Directors for a vote. No second for said motion shall be required. Any motion to be submitted to the Board of Directors for consideration and a vote shall clearly state the name of the person making the motion the body of the motion and the call for the votes of the Directors to be transmitted to the Executive Director within 48 hours. For those Directors not possessing email capability, the Executive Director shall call the Director and register their vote. A super majority of 2/3 of the Board of Directors is required to pass any motion made via email. The results of the motion shall be communicated via email to the Directors as soon as the results are known. The date of this transmission shall become the confirmation date. The date of confirmation and the results of the vote shall be entered into the minutes of the next in-person meeting of the Board of Directors.

Section 5. Notice. Notice of any special meeting of the Board of Directors shall be given at least two days previously thereto by written notice delivered personally or sent by mail or telegram to each Director at his address as shown by the records of the corporation. If mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the United Stated mail in a sealed envelope so addressed, with postage thereon prepaid. If notice be given by telegram, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when the telegram is delivered to the telegraph company. Any Director may waive notice of any meeting. The attendance or telephone participation by a Director at any meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except where a Director attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of, any regular or special meeting of the Board need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting, unless specifically required by law or by these By-laws.

Section 6. <u>Quorum</u>. A majority of the Board of Directors, personally present and participating by telephone, shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board; but if less than a majority of the Directors are present or participating by telephone at said meeting, a majority of the Directors participating at such meeting may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice.

Section 7. Manner of Acting. The act of a majority of the Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors, unless the act of a greater number is required by law or by these By-laws.

Section 8. <u>Compensation</u>. Directors as such shall not receive any stated salaries for their services, but by resolution of the Board of Directors a fixed sum and expenses of attendance, if any, may be allowed for attendance at each regular or special meeting of the Board; but nothing herein contained shall be construed to preclude any director from serving the corporation in any other capacity and receiving compensation therefore.

Section 9. <u>Vacancies</u>. Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors and any directorship to be filled by reason of an increase in the number of Directors, shall be filled by the Board of Directors. A Director elected to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of his predecessor in office.

Section 10. <u>Informal Action by Directors</u>. Any action required by law to be taken at a meeting of directors, or any action which may be taken at a meeting of directors, may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all of the Directors.

ARTICLE IV Officers

Section 1. Officers. The officers of the corporation shall be a President, one or more Vice Presidents (the number thereof to be determined by the Board of Directors), a Secretary and a Treasurer, and such other officers as may be elected in accordance with the provisions of this Article. The Board of Directors may elect or appoint such other officers, including one or more Assistant Secretaries and one or more Assistant Treasurers, as it shall deem desirable, such officers to have the authority and perform the duties prescribed, from time to time, by the Board of Directors. Any two or more offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of President and Secretary.

Section 2. <u>Election and Term of Office</u>. The officers of the corporation shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors at a meeting convened immediately following the adjournment of the annual meeting. Such meeting shall be held without other notice than this By-Law. New offices may be created and filled at any meeting of the Board of Directors. Each officer shall hold office until his successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified.

Section 3. <u>Removal.</u> Any officer elected or appointed by the Board of Directors may be removed by the Board of Directors whenever in its judgment the best interests of the corporation would be served thereby, but such removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the officer so removed.

Section 4. <u>Vacancies</u>. A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation, removal, disqualification or otherwise may be filled by the Board of Directors for the unexpired portion of the term.

Section 5. <u>President.</u> The President shall be the principal executive officer of the corporation and shall in general supervise and control all of the business and affairs of the corporation. He shall preside at all meetings of the members and of the Board of Directors. He may sign, with the Secretary or any other proper officer of the corporation authorized by the Board of Directors, any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the Board of Director has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Board of Directors or by these By-laws or by statute to some other officer or

agent of the corporation; and in general he shall perform all duties incident to the office of President and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors from time to time.

Section 6. <u>Vice President</u>. In the absence of the President or in event of his inability or refusal to act, the Vice President (or in the event there be more than one Vice President, the Vice Presidents in the order of their election) shall perform the duties of the president, and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President. Any Vice President shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him by the President or by the Board of Directors.

Section 7. Secretary. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of the meetings of the members and of the Board of Directors in one or more books provided for that purpose; see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these By-laws or as required by law; be custodian of the corporate records and of the seal of the corporation and see that the seal of the corporation affixed to all documents, the execution of which on behalf of the corporation under its seal is duly authorized in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws; keep a register of the post-office address of each member which shall be furnished to the Secretary by such member, and in general perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him by the President or by the Board of Directors.

Section 8. <u>Treasurer</u>. If required by the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of his duties in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the Board of Directors shall determine. He shall have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds and securities of the corporation; receive and give receipts for moneys due and payable to the corporation from any source whatsoever, and deposit all such moneys in the name of the corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as shall be selected in accordance with the provisions of Articles VII of these By-laws; and in general perform all the duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him by the President or by the Board of Directors.

Section 9. <u>Assistant Treasurers and Assistant Secretaries</u> If required by the Board of Directors, the Assistant Treasurers shall give bonds for the faithful discharge of their duties in such sums and with such sureties as the Board of Directors shall determine. The Assistant Treasurers and Assistant Secretaries, in general, shall perform such duties as shall be assigned to them by the Treasurer or the Secretary or by the President or the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V Committees

Section 1. Committees of Directors. The Board of Directors, by resolution adopted by a majority of the Directors in office, may designate and appoint one or more committees, each of which shall consist of two or more Directors, which committees, to the extent provided in said resolution, shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the corporation; provided, however that no such committee shall have the authority of the Board of Directors in reference to amending, altering or repealing the By-laws; electing, appointing or removing any member of any such committee or Director or officer of the corporation, amending the Articles of Incorporation; authorizing the sale, lease, exchange or mortgage of all or substantially all of the property and assets of the corporation; authorizing the voluntary dissolution of the corporation or revoking proceedings therefor; adopting a plan for the distribution of the assets of the corporation; or amending, altering or repealing any resolution of the Board of Directors which by its terms provides that it shall not be amended, altered or repealed by such committee and the delegation therefor of authority shall not operate to relieve the Board of Directors, or any individual Director of any responsibility imposed upon it or him by law.

Section 2 Other Committees. Other committees not having and exercising the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the corporation may be designated by a resolution adopted by a majority of the Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present. The President of the corporation shall appoint the members thereof. Any member thereof may be removed by the person or persons authorized to appoint such member whenever in their judgment the best interests of the corporation shall be served by such removal.

Section 3. <u>Term of Office</u>. Each member of a committee shall continue as such until the next annual meeting of the corporation and until his successor is appointed, unless the committee shall be sooner terminated, or unless such member be removed from such committee.

Section 4. <u>Chairman</u>. One member of each committee shall be appointed chairman by the person or persons authorized to appoint the members thereof.

Section 5. <u>Vacancies</u>. Vacancies in the membership of any committee may be filled by appointments made in the same manner as provided in the case of the original appointments.

Section 6. <u>Quorum</u>. Unless otherwise provided in the resolution of the Board of Directors designating a committee, a majority of the whole committee shall constitute a quorum and the act of a majority of the member present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the committee.

Section 7. Rules. Each committee may adopt rules for its own government not inconsistent with these Bylaws or with rules adopted by the Board of Directors.

Section 8. <u>Executive Director</u>. The Board of Directors may employ an Executive Director of the Foundation and assign to such Director such duties as may be determined from time to time by the Board. The Board may fix the compensation for such Executive Director.

ARTICLE VI Contracts, Checks, Deposits and Funds

Section 1. <u>Contracts</u>. The Board of Directors may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents of the corporation, in addition to the officers so authorized by these By-laws, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

Section 2. Checks. Drafts. etc. All checks, drafts or orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidence of indebtedness issued in the name of the corporation, shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents of the corporation and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board of Directors. In the absence of such determination by the Board of Directors, such instruments shall be signed by the Treasurer or an Assistant Treasurer and countersigned by the President or a Vice President of the corporation

Section 3 <u>Deposits</u>. All funds of the corporation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Directors may select.

Section 4. <u>Gifts</u>. The Board of Directors may accept on behalf of the corporation any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII Books and Records

The corporation shall keep correct and complete books and records of account and shall also keep minutes of the proceedings of its Board of Directors and committees having any of the authority of the Board of Directors. All books and records of the corporation may be inspected by any Director, or his agent or attorney for any proper purpose at any reasonable time.

ARTICLE VIII Fiscal Year

The fiscal year of the corporation shall begin on the first day of September and end on the last day of August in each year.

ARTICLE IX

Scal

The Board of Directors shall provide a corporate seal, which shall be in the form of a circle and shall have inscribed thereon the name of the corporation and the words "Corporate Seal."

ARTICLE X Waiver of Notice

Whenever any notice is required to be given under the provisions of the Nebraska NonProfit Corporation Act or under the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation or the By-laws of the corporation, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

ARTICLE XI Indemnity of Directors

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the Corporation shall indemnify each person, who by reason of being or having been a trustee or officer of the Corporation is named or otherwise becomes or is threatened to be made a party to any action, suit, investigation, or other proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or otherwise in nature against any and all costs and expenses (including attorney fees, judgments, fines, penalties, amounts paid in settlement, and other disbursements) actually and reasonably incurred by or imposed upon such person in connection with any action, suit, investigation, or proceeding (or any claim or other matter therein), whether civil, criminal, administrative or otherwise in nature, including any settlements thereof or any appeals therein, with respect to which such person is named or otherwise becomes or is threatened to be made a party by reason of being or at any time having been a trustee or officer of the corporation, or by any reason of being or at any time having been at the direction, or request of the corporation, a trustee, or other agent of or fiduciary for the corporation.

ARTICLE XII Amendments to By-Laws

These By-laws may be altered, amended or repealed and new By-laws may be adopted by a two-thirds vote of the Directors present at any regular meeting or at any special meeting, if at least ten days' written notice is given to all Directors of intention to alter, amend or repeal or to adopt new By-laws at such meeting.
