Midwestern State University Foundation, Inc. is a Section 501(c)(3) organization that normally receives a "substantial" part of its support (under a facts and circumstances test) from direct contributions from the public and qualifies as a public charity under IRC Sec. 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) [Reg. 1.170A-9(e)(3)].

Midwestern State University Foundation, Inc. satisfies the requirements to qualify as a public charity under the facts and circumstances test [Reg. 1.170A-9(e)(3)] as follows:

- 1. The public support "normally" received by the organization exceeds at least 10% of the total support "normally" received by the organization. For purposes of the 10% test, the organization used the same four-year test period and definition of total support and public support used in calculating the 33 1/3 % test for public support (including the 2% limit).
- 2. The Midwestern State University Foundation, Inc. is organized and operated to attract new and additional public support on a continuous basis as is stated in its Articles of Incorporation that "the purpose for which the corporation is organized is to receive contributions by means of donations, gifts, and bequests and to expend such funds for the advancement of the literary, scientific, and other educational endeavors of Midwestern State University, a tax-exempt institution of higher learning."
- 3. All pertinent facts and circumstances indicate that Midwestern State University Foundation, Inc. is publicly supported as follows:
 - a. A high percentage of support comes from the public, i.e. 26.42% for YE 8-31-10, 30.31% for YE 8-31-09 and 35.68% for YE 8-31-08.
 - b. The 10% test is satisfied by support from a number of unrelated donors as the Foundation has many different unrelated contributors.
 - c. The Foundation's governing body represents the broad interests of the public by representing the interests of Midwestern State University, a state supported public tax-exempt institution of higher learning.
 - d. The Foundation provides services for the benefit of the general public on a continuous basis by expending funds for scholarships and other programs relating to Midwestern State University.
 - e. The organization maintains a definitive program for accomplishing its charitable work by budgeting and spending funds in accordance with its Articles of Incorporation.
