There are no multi-year grants or grants to endowments, and each organization will be limited to a maximum of one grant every three years.

The following must be included or the request may not be considered:

- Number of copies to be submitted: original plus 8 copies.
- Trustee sponsorship: To facilitate discussion of each proposal at the meeting, each request <u>must</u> indicate the name of the Foundation trustee who has agreed to serve as its sponsor. Sponsorship generally includes trustee involvement with the charity or the program.
- Executive summary of request: No more than two pages, signed by the Board President or Executive Director. (Note: This is in lieu of a full proposal. The trustee who sponsors the proposal will be asked to provide any details, if so requested by the Board at the meeting, so the requesting organization should provide the sponsoring trustee with information that would otherwise be included in a full proposal. Note that the amount requested from the foundation should not exceed the amount the trustee agrees to sponsor.) Do not include a cover letter, a full proposal, or any attachments or brochures; they will not be submitted to the Board for review.
- Budget for the program or project, stapled to the Executive summary.
- If no funding has been made to the organization in the past by any foundations administered by Bank of Hawaii: One copy of the IRS exemption letter, indicating that the charity has 501(c)(3) status and is not a private foundation or support organization, and one copy of Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. (Note: If the organization does not have exempt status issued by the IRS in its name, contact the Foundation Secretary before applying. See below for contact information.)
- Deadline: March 1 delivery to the Foundation at the address below or March 1 postmark.

A narrative report on the project, including its success and/or shortcomings, and a financial report on the use of grant funds is to be submitted upon completion of a project or annually, whichever occurs first. A final report is to be submitted before requesting additional funding.

NOTE: The Strong Foundation requests that no public acknowledgment be made of grant awards.
