The Board established a Compensation Committee, made up of disinterested trustees, who are given the authority to establish compensation for all senior executives, within the parameters of the philosophy, and with full and complete reporting to the full board. The Compensation Committee performs its work pursuant to its charter and a Compensation Policy that establishes the process the committee will follow in reviewing and approving executive compensation each year. In order to assist the Committee in its responsibilities, the Compensation Committee hires independent, outside compensation consultants to advice the committee and the board on the reasonableness of overall executive compensation program, including compensation of the specific executives. These consultants report directly to the Committee and not to Management. The Committee works with these consultants, and with legal counsel, to ensure that all compensation paid, as well as the process followed to determine such compensation, is reasonable, meets all regulatory requirements and is competitive with the relevant market.
