The Forrest General Healthcare Foundation (the Foundation) was established to support the promotion of health within the service area of Forrest General Hospital (the Hospital) and for the benefit of the Hospital. In doing that, the Foundation has embarked on a major five year capital campaign. This campaign seeks to raise funds for the purpose of building a new inpatient hospice home, completeley renovating and expanding the FGH Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and establishing the Spiritual Grounds at Pine Grove Behavioral and Addiction Center (a division of Forrest General Hospital).

Upon completion, the inpatient hospice home will have 12 patient care rooms as well as many family support areas. The average stay for a patient at an inpatient hospice is 2 weeks, therefore the Hospice will potentially serve 312 patients and their families once the home is contructed and operational. In December, 2008, Foundation received a land donation valued at \$360,000 for the future home of the hospice. Foundation is currently working with the City of Hattiesburg regarding

zoning.

Forrest General Hospital's new NICU will institute a new "family-centered care" that will for the first time allow parents to stay in the infant's room and assist in the care of their newborn. The Hospital serves on average 244 babies and their

families in the NICU annually.

The Spiritual Grounds at Pine Grove will offer a unique opportunity for both patients and our community to benefit from an "urban oasis". Pine Grove Behavioral and Addiction Center serves on average 4,487 patients per year. Different elements of the Spiritual Grounds will be incorporated into the treatment program for each of our patients. The Spiritual Grounds will become a place of reflection and growth that will assist many in the recovery process. During 2008, Phase 1 (Circle of Healing/McMullan Plaza) of the Spiritual Grounds was completed and patients began holding some group sessions at the Circle of Healing Plaza. The meditation garden (Phase 2) will be completed in 2010.
