The Central Illinois Agency on Aging provides funding for a home delivered meal program for the Central Illinois counties of Peoria, Tazewell, Fulton, Marshall, Stark and Woodford. Meals are provided by organizations each in service area and funds are provided to each organizations by way of grants(contracts). Under the Older American Act, meals are provided to older persons on a donation basis only and must meet the nutritional requirements set forth by the Older Americans Act in the 2006 Amendment. Meals are delivered to the older person's home and are intended for the home-bound. These funds allow for older persons to stay in their homes and communities avoiding institutionalization. Grant (contract) funds received are required to be locally matched. Unused grant (contract) funds are carried over into the following fiscal year.

Central Illinois Agency on Aging in coorporation with the Center for Prevention of Abuse provides a Elder Abuse and Neglect Program. The program is administered through the Illinois Department on Aging. It is designed to respond to older persons who are victims of abuse, neglect, and exploitation by building on the existing legal, medical, and social service system to be responsive to the needs of elder abuse victims and their families. The service delivery componets of the program are: screening and intake of reports, assessment, case work and follow-up. Early interventrion services are available to assist the elder abuse victims ability to
	obtain needed services. These include: legal assistance, housing and relocation assistance, respite care and emergency aid (food, clothing and medical care).

The Central Illinois Agency on Aging provides funding for congregate meal programs throughout our service area, which includes the Central Illinois counties of Peoria, Tazewell, Fulton, Marshall, Stark and Woodford. Meals are provided by organizations in each of our service areas and funds are provided to each organizations by way of grants. Under the Older Americans Act, meals are provided to older persons at predetermined locations and are on a donation only basis. All meals must meet the nutritional requirements set forth by the Older Americans Act in the 2006 Amnedment. These programs provide mobile older persons socialization and support in addition to balanced nutrition. Grant (contract) funds received are required to be locally matched. Unused grant (contract) funds are carried over into the following year.
