The Society, in each of it Conferences(the primary basic unit ifthe Society of St. Vincent de Paul), makes no distinction regarding gender, wealth, occupation, social status or ethnic origin. the Society has three types of members: the Active(Full) Member, the Associate Member, and the Contributing Member. Active(Full) Member are those who participate regularly in the prayer life, meetings and charitable activities through personal contact with the poor of the Vincentian Conference or Council into which they have been recieved. Active (full) member accepts the Rule and Statues of the Society, belongs to the Catholic Church, and is recieved as a Vincentian brother or sister into the Society's Conference or Council with which he or sheis affliated. Admission Process for Active Members: the names of person's proposed for active membership are to be submitted to the President of the Conference or Counsil concerned. The President will provide information concerning the recommended person to the Conference or Council. If approved, the candidate will be admitted as a member and given a Vincentian welcome at the next meeting. Associate Membersare those affliated with the Society by formal action of the Conference or Council with which the member will be joined. Associate Members include those who sincerly and publicly accept the Society's Rule but may or may not belong to the Catholic Church and may or may not attend Conference Meetings or engage in the works of the Society ona regular basis. Contributing Members are those who regularly or in a substanial way provide in-kind or financial support but do not enagage directly in the Society's work. All decisions are made by consensus after the necessary prayer, reflection and consultation.

Form 990, Part VI, Section A, Line 7a - The Society of St. Vincent de Paul in the Archdiocesan of Detroit has three levels of Goverance. The Conference is the primary basic unit. All members belong to a conference. Conference memebers must meet at least twice a month. Each conference has a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The President is elected in a secrete ballot of the conference members. The President appoints the other offices. A group of three or more conferences form a District Council. The conference presidents elect their district council's President. The district council president appoints the district council's officers. The Archdiocesan Council is composed of a duly elected presidents and the district presidents and the presidents of the district councils. The Archdiocesan Council's president is elected by the Archdiocesan Council memebers. Each Archdiocesan Council member has one vote. Once a quorum is present at a meeting, simple majority of those eligible to vote is required to approve or disapprove a resolution. The president of the Archdiocesan Council's board appoints at large members of the board of directors and officers. The term of the Conference, District and (Arch) Diocesan Council presidents is three years, once renewable. Once a president has served for two consecutive three-year terms, that person will bet be eligible for a re-election as president until a three-year term has elapsed under a different president.

Form 990, Part VI, Section A, Line 7b - For reasons prompted by the seriousness of a particular situation, the President General may suspend temporally or permanently exclude a Council or a member, after notifying the Permanent Section according. In case of a permanent exclusion this always entail the cancellation of the Institution. The National President is given the power through extraordinary deligation to temporarily suspend a Council or member exclusively as precautionary measure. In such circumstances the President General shall be notified of such decision and the justified reasons for the same, within a maximum of 15 working days; the Council or memeber in question may appeal to the National Council President's conciliation process in effectat that time. The President General shall approve or reject the appeals that are presented.
