The Board monitors actual expenditures via its budget review. Record keeping is the responsibility of each group managing an assistance category.

USDA and similarly controlled food distribution is monitored in accordance with donating agency policy with required reports submitted to those agencies.

Because Fish operates on a cash basis, though we do not figure the cost of food or supplies donated to us, these donations are logged. For kitchen meals & groceries,

our client assistance is significantly augmented by such community and agency food donations - religious/school groups, US Post Office, Boy Scouts, USDA, etc.

The costs in column (c) represent Fish's actual cash expenditures in support of the particular form of assistance. In the case of rent, utility, and pharmacy assistance,

the cash payments are made to the client's rental/utility/pharmacy company and not to the client. We minimize the risk of clients "double dipping" by

coordinating assistance with other community organizations.

Kitchen meals are served daily on site and provided to all who come to the "kitchen". The approximate counts are based on sign in sheet totals.

Groceries assistance is provided to a family/single no more than once every 30 days - 3 full bags. Rent, utility, and pharmacy assistance are provided no more than

once a year. In addition, Fish provides Thanksgiving and Christmas baskets, providing a holiday meal for a family/single. Accurate counts are based on logs.

The "phone service" is for our client contact phone service and for reimbursement of reasonable phone expenses of those coordinating the assistance requests.
