Consideration shall also be given to those who express an interest in attending a program which leads to a job skill certification at an accredited trade, industrial, or technical institution.
- 8. Race, color, creed, national origin, gender, age, or physical disability shall not be considered as negative factors making the determination of the award(s). Equal opportunity shall be given to any student to make application and to be considered.
- 9. Previous recipients are eligible to re-apply for this scholarship throughout the course of their educational career.

IV. Selection: The scholarship(s) will be awarded upon the recommendation of the

Trustees, who shall also be responsible for any follow-up actions.

V. Applications: Application blanks may be secured from the Guidance Department of the

Weir Senior High School. Completed applications must be returned to the Weir Senior High School Guidance Department on or before APRIL 1,

2010.

VI. Notification: The recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) will be notified at the Weir High

Senior Recognition.
