This study was recently published and can be found on the Water Missions website. The health impact study showed an approximate 52% reduction of clinical visits for diarrheal diseases in the 43 months after the community water systems becomes fully operational. In the summer of 2010 an similar health impact study was begun in conjunction with a new instrative, Water for Africa. To our knowledge no such study has been performed and published. These studies are multi year and will be published as results are available. Form 990, Part III, Line 4d, Other Program Services: Research & Development --Completed production model for a major redesign of the living water treatment system and erosion chlorinator. These changes focused on using molded components, replacing the current chlorinator and valve manifold, improving operation, ease of use, and reducing the cost per water system over \$500. Testing and refining of the newly designed LWTS is almost complete. Assembly and operation manuals are being produced. The newly designed system will be shipped pre assembled to minimize the initial installation time, cutting the time down to minutes rather than hours before safe water is produced. Quality control monitoring of the living water treatment system and various components is underway.
