One significant project, Project Safewater-Colon is a multi-year, \$4.6 million project serving the residents of Colon, Honduras. By September 2010, this project had provided concrete sanitary pit latrines to more than 10,331 families and sustainable safe water to more than 260,000 people. Disaster Response--

After the January 12th Haiti earthquake, 115 living water treatment systems (LWTS) and erosion chlorinators were installed, serving more than 200,000 people. Five sanitary pit latrine mold sets were delivered to Haiti, which are capable of providing the housing of 15,000 concrete latrines. Nine living water treatment systems were also installed in Pakistan, following the devastating flooding in August. In all of our disaster response projects, the goal is to move to long term community development. That process has begun in Haiti.

LWTS is almost complete. Assembly and operation manuals are being  
produced. The newly designed system will be shipped pre assembled to  
minimize the initial installation time, cutting the time down to  
minutes rather than hours before safe water is produced. Quality  
control monitoring of the living water treatment system and various  
components is underway.
