FACES ensures that in-home support services, day services, and assistance in understanding and using Medicaid waivers are available for the participants, as well as volunteer and employment opportunities. From October 2009 through September 2010, 85 participants with developmental disabilities were placed in host homes, for a total of 25,915 days in care. On average, 71 participants were in care each day.

Foster families receive full support from LSG's team, including case management and on-going training. LSG has a proven track record of accomplishment, providing high quality services to foster children and families.
