4a	(Code: ) (Expenses \$ 10,472,909 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ ) The Carl Sagan Center for the Study of Life in the Universe (CSC) specializes in the broad interdisciplinary field of astrobiology, striving to understand the origin, evolution and distribution of life in the universe. Our scientists are
	addressing three of the most profound questions in science: How does life arise? Is there life beyond Earth? and What are the future directions for the evolution of life? CSC scientists publish the results of their research in peer reviewed journal articles and book chapters and give presentations to their colleagues and the public. Many also mentor students, training the next generation of scientists. Examples of some of the exciting research conducted by our scientists in FY 10 are: *Using telescopes & laboratory experiments to understand the complex chemistry that
	takes place in the clouds of gas and dust between the stars. *Revealing the strange phenomena that occur in ring systems around planets and in the formation process of planets. *Exploring remote locations on Earth, from the Arctic to the Antarctic to the Atacama Desert, to understand the ability of life to adapt to extreme environments. *Searching for planetary systems around other suns. *Probing the surface and subsurface environments on Mars to reveal the history of the planet and address the questions of whether life is now, or once was, present there.
4b	(Code: ) (Expenses \$ 1,767,819 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ )  The Allen Telescope Array (ATA) is a unique instrument designed to seek out signals from civiliations elsewhere in the universe while simultaneously conducting other radio astronomy research. Science conducted on the array during FY 10 has resulted in several published papers and presentations at scientific meetings. Additionally, since the ATA is the first instrument of its type, we have begun exploring what unique capabilities it may have to augment the United States Air Force Space Command's Space Surveillance mission. The ATA could be an important tool to
	support this mission in areas such as accurate tracking of GEO satellites and tracking objects during daylight hours.  These capabilities could have an important impact on improving the Space Command's Space Surveillance  Network and therefore increase the overall safety of space.

	The Center for Education and Outreach (EDU) at the SETI Institute conducts projects in formal and informal education and public outreach. These projects include curriculum development & teacher professional development, museum exhibit development, and outreach to students, teachers and the general public. The Institute is involved in scientific and educational trade shows, workshops, and courses which share the Institute scientific research. FY 10 was the fifth year of our Astrobiology Research Experience for Undergraduates program, sponsored by the NSF. To
	date, more than 50% of our REU students are pursuing advanced degrees. Of particular note, the SETI Institute hosts a science radio program, "Big Picture Science" (formerly, "Are We Alone?"), which reaches millions of listeners world-wide through broadcast and download podcasts. In addition, EDU staff present talks nationwide and lead education/outreach programs for NASA's Kepler, SOFIA Missions and NASA's Astrobiology Institute.
