RESTRICTIONS:

- The Foundation will consider a request from organizations that are based in or will directly benefit the Webster Five's delineated community, in amounts ranging from \$1,000 to \$15,000.
- The Foundation will support organizations involved in: Youth Services, Senior Services, Health and Social Services.
- The Foundation will consider the following types of support: Annual Campaigns, Program Development, and Emergency Funds.

The Foundation will NOT support:

Individuals, political organizations/candidates, churches, synagogues or mosques, fraternal organizations, employment union, tax supported entities. Exceptions to the tax-supported entity exclusion will be considered for library capital campaigns that are support by a private funding program..

The foundation discourages repeat requests for funding for the same program/project. A repeat request for funding should be well documented. Unusual or emergency circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
