

In 2010 the Michigan Movers Association conducted a comprehensive, three stage membership drive, offered a discount for renewing members who paid early, and informed the public of our members availability via our website.

We sent out weekly e-newsletters regarding Michigan=s business climate, provided periodic legislative updates and actively lobbied on legislation to amend the Michigan Business Tax to help save our members who use contract labor from double taxation.

We hosted our annual convention in February, and again produced four quarterly newsletters. We interacted regularly with the MPSC to ensure the industry was protected and that unlicensed movers were contacted and either became licensed or ceased operations. Our Tariff Committee again sought an increase in tariff rates through the MPSC which was ultimately withdrawn due to economic factors. We will be updating and modernizing our website in the coming year and continue to offer membership discounts and early pay incentives. The year ended with our Executive Committee approved our 2011 budget which yields a significant profit for the coming year.
