The study of salivary gland cancer led to the discovery that the approved drug rapamycin may have great potential in the treatment of this cancer. A new method was developed to better study the cells that line and protect the prostate in relation to the development of cancer. Using this model, they found that normal cells and cancer cells depend on different factors to survive, which could aid in discovering how to target cancer cills without affecting normal cells when developing treatments. In collaboration with rese archers at other organizations, a biomarker that could help in the treatment of patients with an aggressive type of lung cancer was discovered. Researchers identified an enzyme that could help diagnose and treat a form of liver cancer. A method was developed to predict whether pancreatic cysts are benign or are precursors to invasive cancer. Pancreatic cancer is often diagnosed in advanced stages beyond standard treatme
