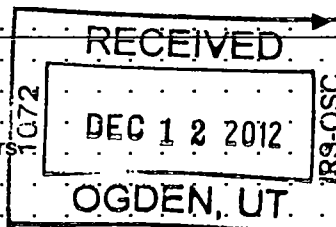



The Cabot Community Association (CCA) was incorporated in Vermont on May 8, 1998. It is a corporation in good standing in Vermont.

The corporation's purposes were generally to provide a vehicle for community members to do good works in the town. A copy of the

Articles of Incorporation is enclosed. The corporation applied for and was granted an advance ruling as a 501(c)(3) corporation in 1998

(a copy of the notification is enclosed) and filed for 8734 in 2003. A copy of the acknowledgement is enclosed. Subsequently the organi-

zation became dormant.

In 2012 it became necessary to establish a tax-exempt community organization to act as fiduciary for a variety of community activities

which included a school mentoring program, a youth soccer league and the local monthly community newspaper, the Cabot Chronicle.

Will Walters, the remaining CCA board member, offered the CCA as such a vehicle and informed the new board that he had made the annual

filings with the IRS to maintain the tax status. From your notice CP259E dated November 12, 2012 it appears that the 990-N for the year

ended 12-31-2010 was not filed. The CCA did file the 990-N for the year ended 12-31-2011. The organization has been active and has

received both governmental and non-governmental funding in 2012. It has employees and has filed it's required payroll tax returns.

It is our sincere hope that the IRS will accept this late filing.

# **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

## **THE CABOT COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED**

We, the undersigned, being of lawful age and residents of Vermont and citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Vermont, by these Articles of Incorporation, have associated and hereby associate ourselves together, as a body politic and corporate according to the provisions of Chapter 19, Title XI of the Vermont Statutes and of said State relating thereto and prescribing the duties and powers of corporations, under the corporate name and for the purposes hereinafter set forth.

### **ARTICLE 1 - NAME**

The name of this corporation shall be THE CABOT COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED (hereinafter referred to as THE CCA).

### **ARTICLE II - INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT**

The initial registered agent shall be RICHARD D. (R.D.) ENO, with registered office at 32 THISTLE HILL ROAD, CABOT, VERMONT 05647.

### **ARTICLE III - PLACE OF BUSINESS**

The location and principal place of business of THE CCA shall be Cabot, Vermont, or such other places as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine. The initial mailing address of THE CCA shall be 32 THISTLE HILL ROAD, CABOT, VERMONT 05647.

### **ARTICLE IV - OPERATING YEAR**

THE CCA shall operate on a fiscal year beginning January 1.

### **ARTICLE V - PERIOD OF DURATION**

The period of duration of THE CCA shall be perpetual.

## **ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP**

THE CCA shall be a non-membership organization

## **ARTICLE VII - PURPOSES**

THE CCA shall be a non-profit association formed exclusively for charitable and educational purposes under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of subsequently enacted Federal Law. These purposes shall be.

1. to acquire and maintain facilities for carrying out the purposes of THE CCA;
2. to create and maintain a community center as a multi-purpose facility to bring Cabot residents together in common endeavor, recreation and personal enrichment;
3. to provide a venue for public discussion groups, panels, forums, lectures, workshops and other programs consistent with the purposes of THE CCA;
4. to provide opportunities for cross-generational interaction;
5. to provide youth-oriented programs promoting healthy choices on matters such as substance abuse, sexuality, educational opportunities, family issues, and recreation;
6. to provide programs and opportunities for senior citizens;
7. to promote the arts through performances, workshops, visiting artists, classes, community arts projects, exhibitions, etc. with special opportunities for local artists and emphasis on local outreach;
8. to undertake such other charitable and educational activities, consistent with the above-stated purposes and with the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of subsequently enacted Federal Law, as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine.

## **ARTICLE VIII - NON-PROFIT CORPORATION**

THE CCA is organized as a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 19, Title XI of Vermont Statutes, and shall not have authority to issue any capital stock. The property of THE CCA shall be used solely to promote its purposes as herein defined. No substantial part of the activities of THE CCA shall consist of carrying propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. No part of the activities of THE CCA shall consist of participating in or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. No part of the net assets or earnings of THE CCA shall inure to the benefit of, or be

- distributed to its officers, trustees, directors, donors, employees or other private persons, except that THE CCA shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set for in these Articles. Upon any dissolution or winding up of THE CCA, any assets remaining after payment of or provision for its debts and liabilities shall, consistent with the purposes of THE CCA, be paid over to charitable corporations qualifying as exempt organizations under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of subsequently enacted Federal Law, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of THE CCA is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, THE CCA shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

#### **ARTICLE IX - POLICY OF NON-DISCRIMINATION**

THE CCA shall operate without discrimination with respect to race, national origin, handicap, religion, age, color, sex, or sexual orientation in relation to the services provided by THE CCA, in relation to the recruitment, hiring, retention or serving on Board of Directors or committees of THE CCA, and in relation to the hiring, treatment and promotion of employees.

#### **ARTICLE X - POWERS**

THE CCA shall have all the general powers conferred by Chapter 19, Title XI of the Vermont Statutes and all amendments thereto, and all other powers necessary, desirable or incidental fully to effectuate its corporate purposes including but not limited to the power to acquire real or personal property by grant, gift, demise, bequest or purchase, and to hold, lease, mortgage or dispose of such property as the purposes of THE CCA shall require.

#### **ARTICLE XI - COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW**

The Board of Directors of THE CCA shall ensure that every action taken by THE CCA complies with the requirements imposed upon non-profit corporations by Chapter 19, Title XI of Vermont Statutes, and all amendments thereto, and with all local, state and federal laws.

## **ARTICLE XII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The initial Board of Directors of THE CCA shall have 7 (seven) members, with the following serving as directors until their successors be selected and qualify:


