NOTE A: SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Business Activity

Merrimack Valley Housing Partnership, Inc. is a private, non-profit organization whose mission is to promote home ownership opportunities for low and moderate income earners in the Merrimack Valley region of Massachusetts.

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of Merrimack Valley Housing Partnership, Inc. have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

Basis of Presentation

The financial statements are presented in accordance with Statement of Financial Accounting Standards No. 117, Financial Statements of Not-For-Profit Organizations, which requires the Organization to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets. The Organization has no temporarily restricted net assets.

Investments

Investments_in_marketable_securities_with_readily_determinable_fair_values are reported at their fair values on the statement of financial position. Unrealized gains and losses are included in the change in net assets.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Endowment Fund

The Organization established a permanent non-revocable Endowment Fund during 2000. Monies have been permanently transferred to the Greater Lowell Community Foundation which holds this investment and other Organizations' investments in a pooled investment account. The amount of \$9,937, from earnings, was transferred from the endowment fund to the current fund in 2010.

NOTE C: DOWN PAYMENT ASSISTANCE LOANS RECEIVABLE

The Organization-provides down-payments for qualifying home-purchasers to facilitate timely home buying closings. Proper legal documents are signed by the borrower assuring repayment to the Organization. All loans are short-term, non-interest bearing loans usually repaid in less than thirty days. Most down payment loans receivable were repaid in January, 2011.
