The audited financial statements for The Kensico Cemetery provide the following description of its Endowment Funds:

The Permanent Maintenance Fund - was established in 1949 as provided by New York State law. Effective July 1, 1992, the fund receives 15% of the gross proceeds from the sale of all lots, crypts and niches. As also required by New York State law, effective January 1, 2001, the fund receives an additional \$35 for each interment. New York State law also provides that the principal of this fund shall remain inviolate except under limited circumstances, as set forth in the law. Income (interest and dividends) from the investments of this fund is deposited in the General Fund to be used for current maintenance of the Cemetery. Capital gains and losses from investments are added to or reduce the principal of the fund.

The Declaratory Maintenance Fund - was established in 1934 as provided in the judgement in an action in the Supreme Court, Westchester County, entitled The Kensico Cemetery, plaintiff against William H. Lyon, et al, defendents. Pursuant to the judgement, investments of the General Fund having a book value of \$147,551 were transferred to this fund. The judgement provides that the principal and income of this fund shall not be used for the general purpose of the Cemetery until the fund, including accumulated income, is in an amount sufficient to produce income to maintain in perpetuity the grounds of the Cemetery. This fund has been administered in accordance with the provisions of the Lyons judgement.

The following Policy was adopted by the Board of Directors of The Kensico Cemetery ("the Cemetery") on September 6, 2007, to be effective as of October 25, 2007:

Purpose

This Policy has been adopted to assure that the business of the Cemetery is conducted free from possible influence or conflicts of interest of Board members or Officers of the Cemetery.

Duty to Disclose

In furtherance of Section 4.01 of the Cemetery's By-laws, any Board member or Officer having an interest in a contract or other transaction being considered by the Board shall disclose such interest to the Board. An interested Director shall not participate in deliberations of the Board nor vote with respect to such contract or transaction. Furthermore, each Board member and Officer shall complete a conflict of interest questionnaire upon becoming a Board member or Officer and annually thereafter, and shall promptly notify the President of any changes to the information provided in the last completed questionnaire.

Review of Disclosed Information

The President shall review all disclosed information and may take appropriate action to resolve any reported potential conflicts. Any existing conflicts not previously disclosed to the Board and any unresolved potential conflicts shall be referred to the Audit Committee with the President's recommendation, if any, regarding a resolution. The Audit Committee shall consider whether any recommendation of the President should be implemented or if different action is appropriate. The Board, when it deems necessary, may review any such determination of the Audit Committee and make modifications thereto.

Gifts and Entertainment

No Board member or Officer shall accept gifts or entertainment from persons dealing with the Cemetery that might be considered by an objective observer to have the potential for influencing his or her conduct of the business of the Cemetery. This requirement is not intended to prohibit the exchange of social amenities or business courtesies consistent with good taste and mature judgment.

THE KENSICO CEMETERY POLICY ON THE PROCESS OF DETERMINING COMPENSATION

The following policy was adopted by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on December 3, 2008

PART VI LINE 15 6

Pursuant to §715(b) of the New York Not-For-Profit Corporation Law and Section 6.05 of the By-Laws of The Kensico Cemetery, compensation paid to officers is fixed by the Board of Directors at the Annual Budget meeting of the Board held in December each year. An affirmative vote of a majority of the entire Board is required when fixing officers' compensation. The compensation established at the Annual Budget meeting applies for the following calendar year. As with all Board meetings, written Minutes with respect to the deliberations and decisions of the Board regarding compensation are contemporaneously made and maintained. The Board will follow this same process with respect to any non-officer key employee.

In determining the compensation of officers and key employees, the Board will consider:

- 1. Comparable compensation data available from public and private services relating to not-for-profit institutions, cemeteries and other organizations;
 - 2. The performance of the Cemetery as a whole and the performance of each aspect of the Cemetery's operation and services, the enhancement of the Cemetery trust funds and the general economy; and
 - 3. The personal performance of the officer or key employee.

Any officer or key employee who is a member of the Board shall be excused for the portion of the Annual Budget Meeting that determines the compensation of that officer or key employee.

As used herein, the term "compensation" shall include salaries, fees and fringe benefits provided to officers and term "key employee" shall have the same meaning as provided in the IRS instructions to Form 990.
